1-2) Of *mahārājādhirāja śrī Samudragupta*, the exterminator of all kings, without equal on earth, the daughter's son (*dauhitra*) of the *Licchavis*, begotten on *mahādevī Kumāradevī*, the great grandson of *mahārāja śrī Gupta*, the grandson of *maharaja śrī Ghaṭotkaca*, the son of *mahārājādhirāja śrī Candragupta*.

2-4) His son, approved by him (for the throne) and himself) without an equal, was *paramabhāgavata mahārājādhirāja śrī Candragupta*, begotten on *mahādevī Dattadevī*. His son, who meditated on his feet, who was begotten on *mahādevī Dhruvadevī*, was *mahārājādhirāja śrī Kumāragupta*.

4-8) His son, who meditated on his feet, who was begotten on *mahādevī Anantadevī*, was *mahārājādhirāja śrī Purugupta*.
