2. Badges diagram

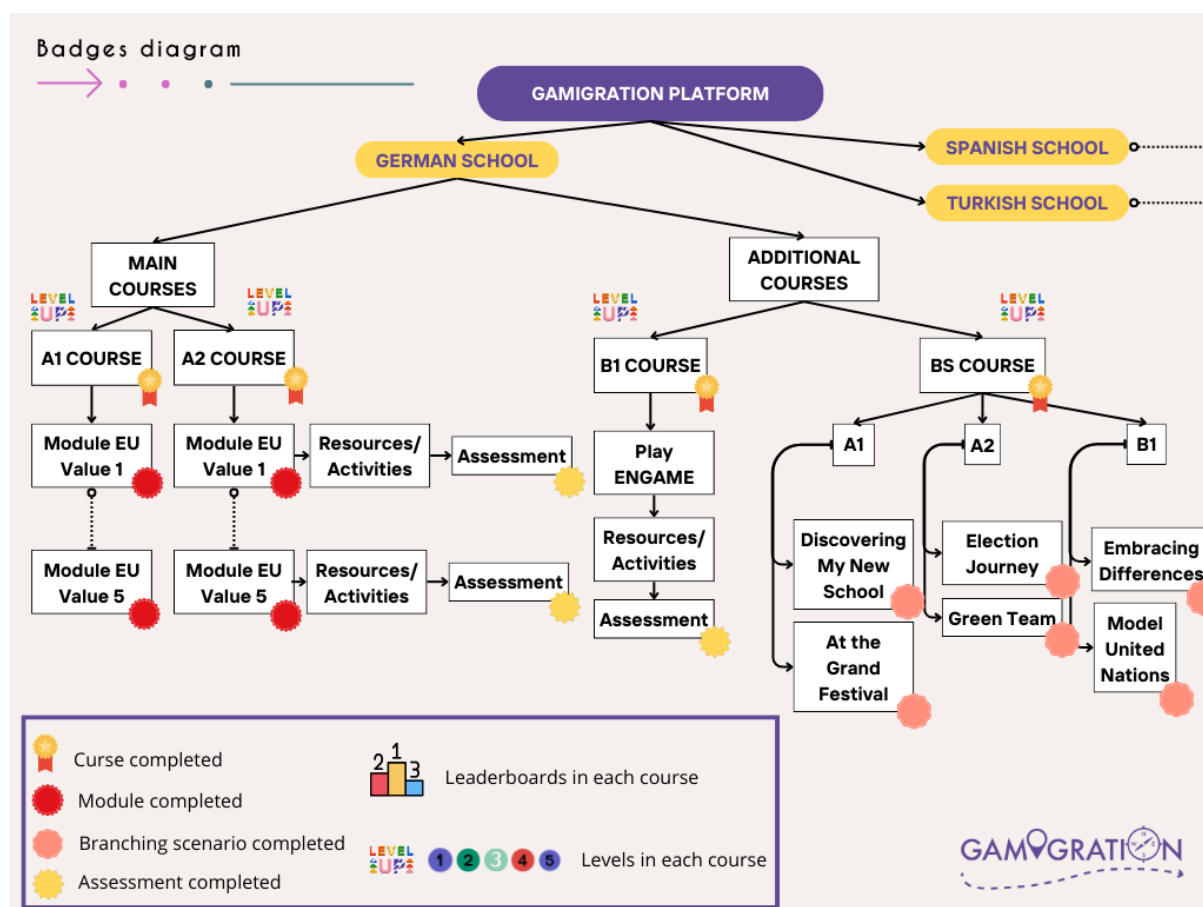


Figure 1. Badges distribution in the GAMIGRATION courses

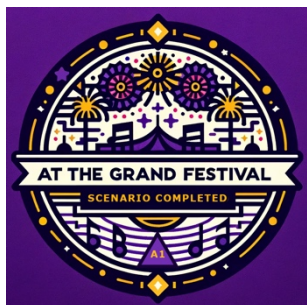
