Short description of the data and the program

The paper uses data from the FROGEE Gender Equality in Eastern Europe Survey. The data is available online and provided free of charge for scientific purposes, after registration. The program used for the analysis underlying the respective article includes one STATA do-file written in STATA version 17. At the top of the do-file the user needs to define their paths. To run the do-file the user needs to download the data from the FROGEE Gender Equality in Eastern Europe Survey provided under the following link: <https://zenodo.org/records/10777928>, and Authors' compilation of the general statistics on prevalence of intimate partner violence on country level from different sources (freely available online from these sources) provided in the Excel file: 'IPV_externalstats.xlsx', which can be downloaded together with the do-file.

The respective do-file runs all analysis, calculates several weighting schemes (including some robustness checks conducted at the stage of the review of the article, though not used in the final version of the article), prepares all the figures and tables provided in the article.
