# Where do I speak from?

## Type of institutions served by Couperin:

Universities ; research institutions ; hospitals, others

## Number of institutions served: 279

- **Staff:** 21 volunteers elected at Couperin's Steering Committee, 6 volunteers elected for executive coordination, 11 volunteers elected at Couperin's board, **8 permanent staff**, 132 volunteer negotiators, 60 volunteers in 4 working groups

## Top 3 activity areas

- Negotiation of resources at the best price
- Promotion of open science
- Metrics to facilitate negotiations

**It is mainly run by volunteers supported by 8 permanent staff**

**Our strength: being a key actor in the **network** of information specialists in Higher Education & Research**

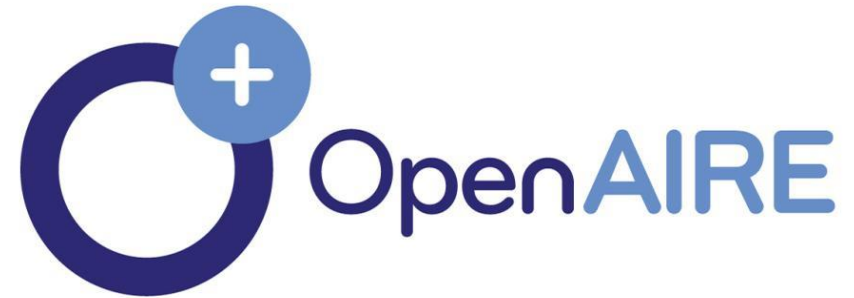

# Coordination rather than direct training

- Couperin is the NOAD (National Open Access Desk) for France since 2009

## NOAD's role focuses on

- harvesting EC-funded publications at the beginning
- Then data repositories
- Making repositories compliant with OpenAIRE guidelines
- disseminating information
- liaising with the various French open science initiatives (Ministry, funders, Couperin's members, etc.)
- providing training
