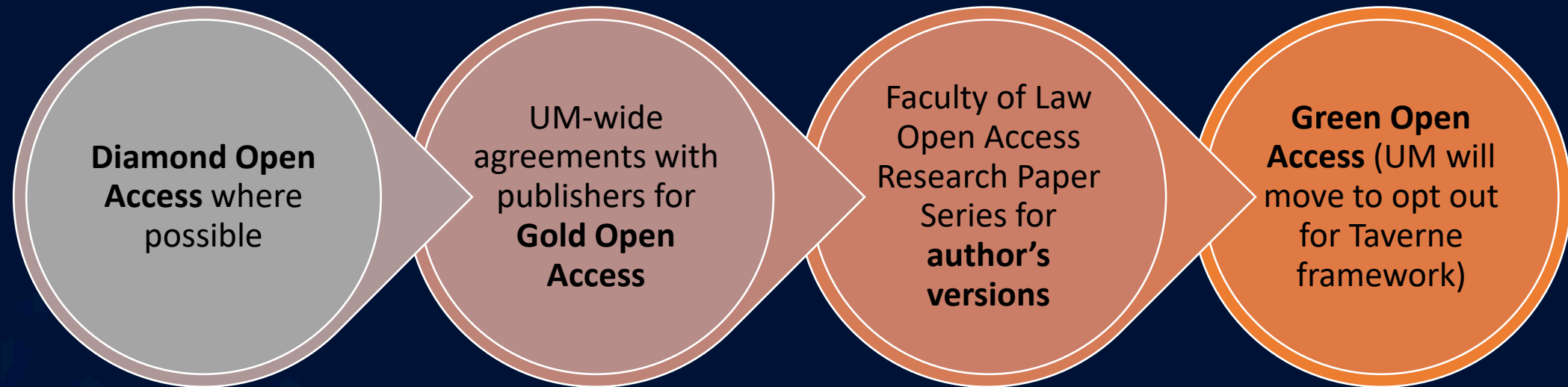

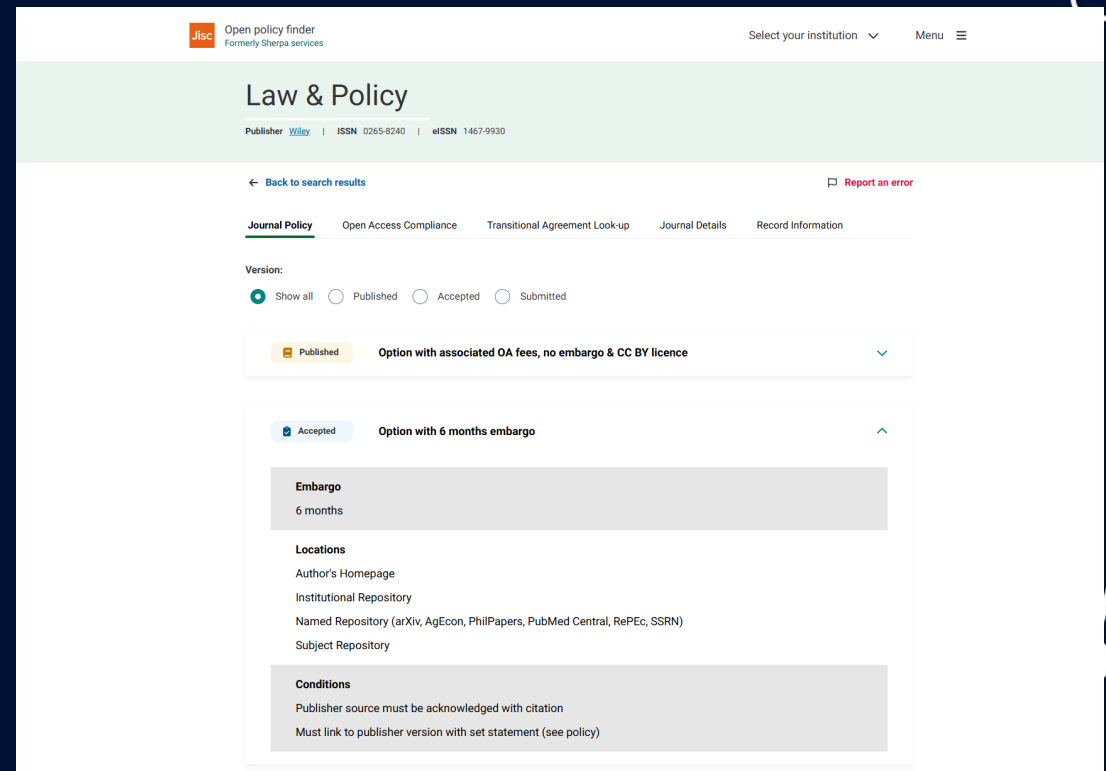

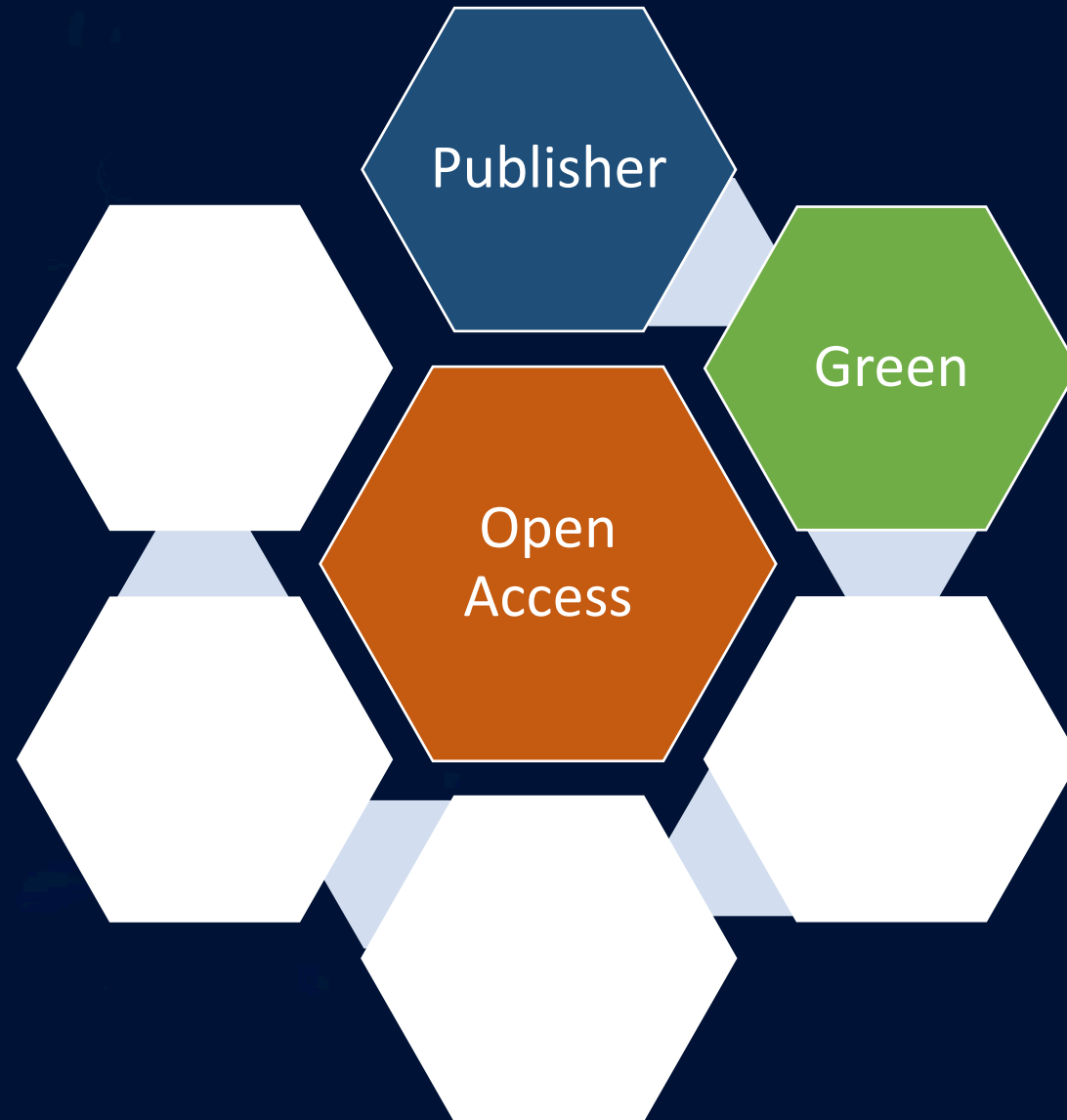

- Author versions or VoR (Taverne)
- Delayed OA (except ...)
- No CC license (except ...)
- Not Compliant (except ...)

Taverne – You share, we take care!

Taverne (Dutch Copyright Law) makes it legal to share paywalled articles of UM and MUMC+ scholars with the world via UM Research Information (Pure). Please sign up for our free "You share, we take care!" service here.

Sometimes you can't publish an article Open Access. Maybe you forgot or couldn't afford it. The Dutch Copyright Act (Taverne amendment) allows you to share your paywalled articles and make them accessible to the world.

And even better. The University Library does this for you! You only need to send in the consent form.

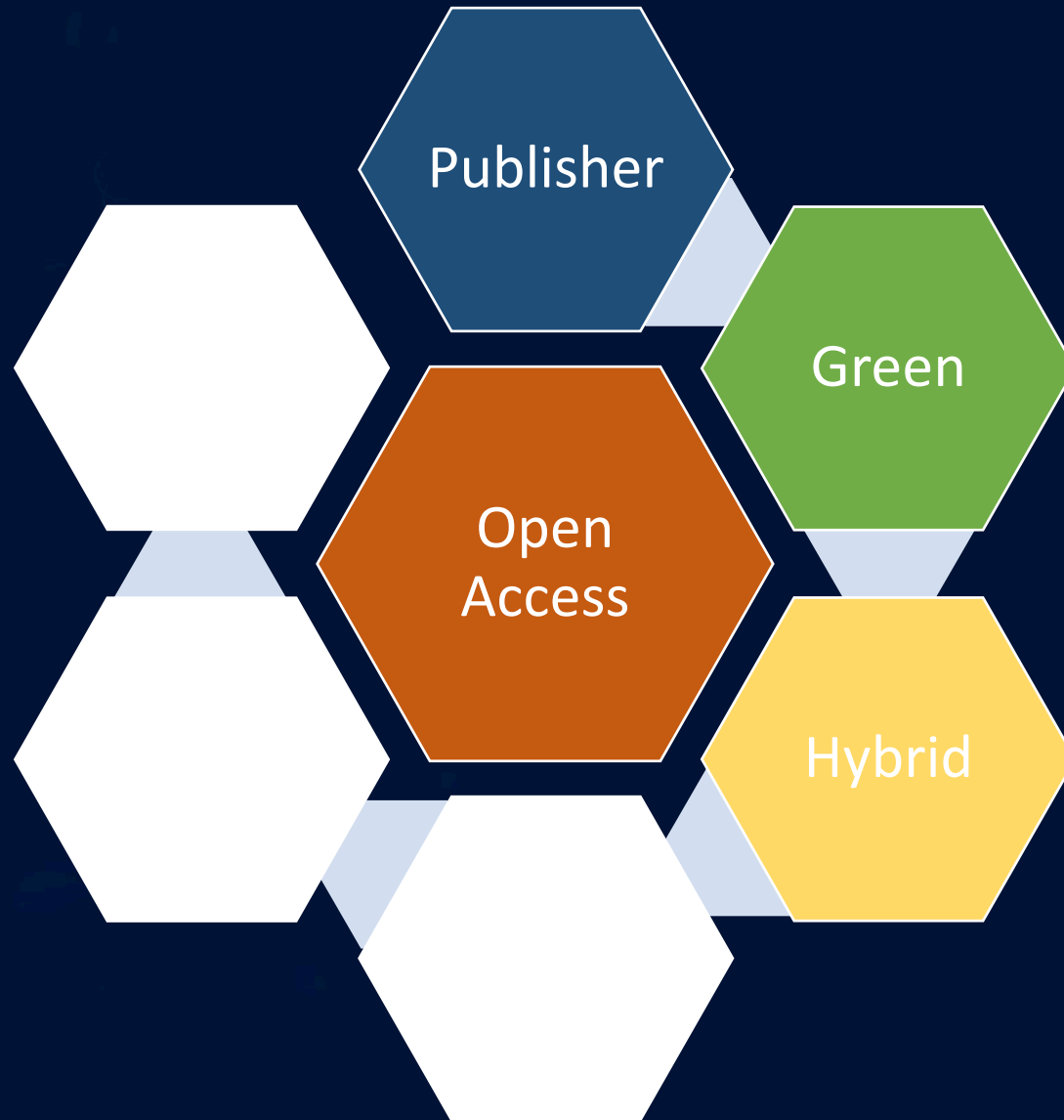
From that moment on, the library will ensure that the full text (PDF) of your past and future paywalled publications registered in Pure are disclosed correctly via [Maastricht University | MUMC+ Research Information](#) six months after publication. And from there with all the major indexes and search engines. And if you want to



UM and MUMC+ scholars can benefit from numerous Open Access arrangements the library has made with publishers. Find out how to take advantage of these APC discounts.

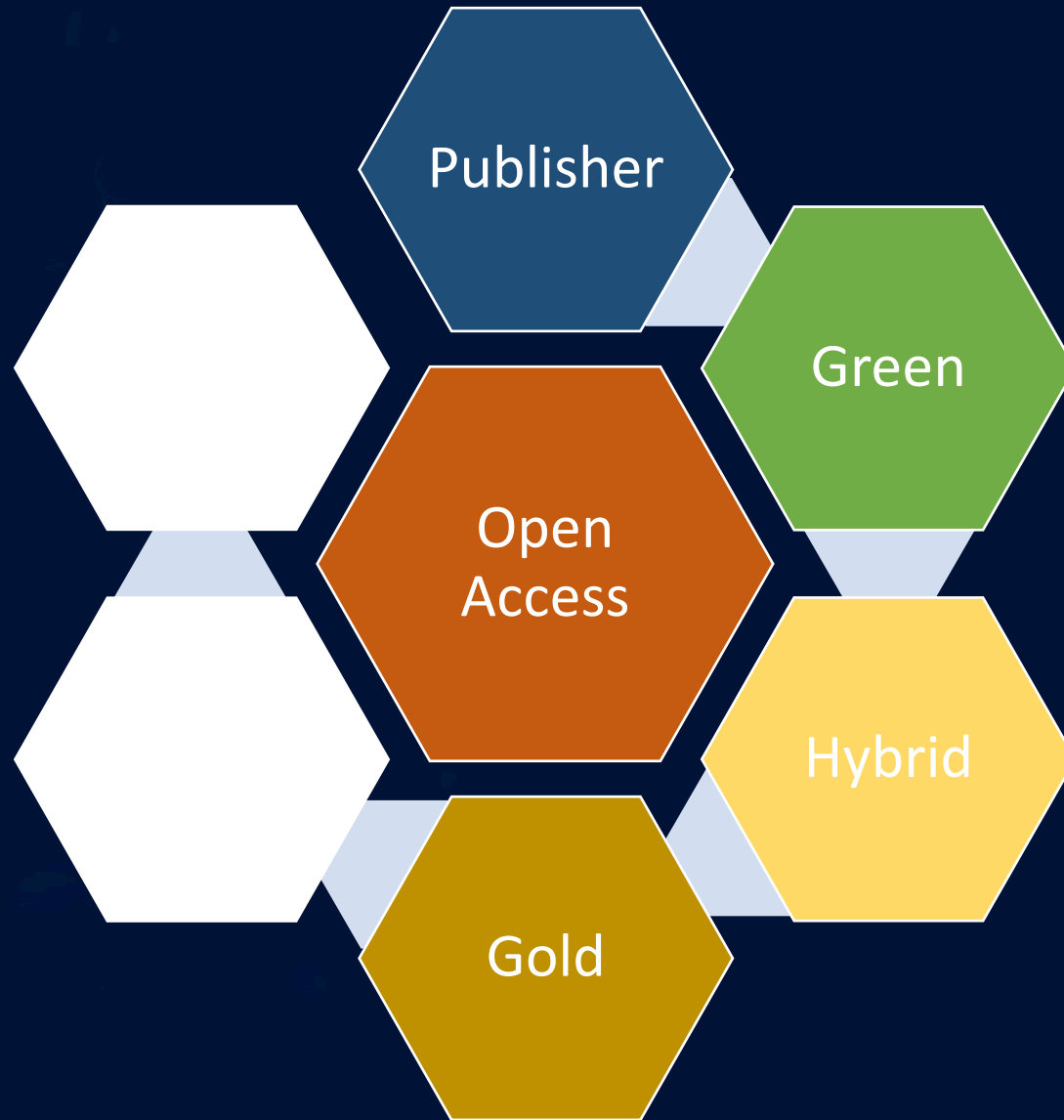

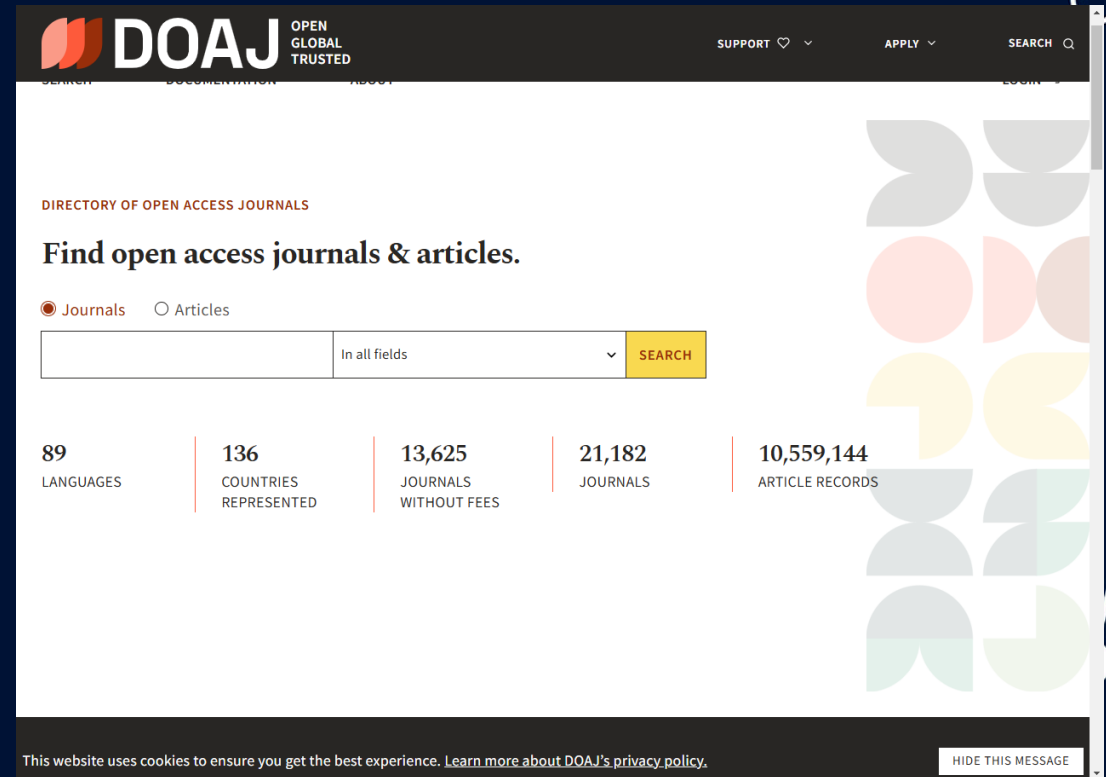

- No subscriptions
- Open Access only – APC
- Immediate OA
- Retain Copyright
- CC license
- Funder compliant
- Beware of predatory publishers
- [OA Journal Browser](#) - DOAJ

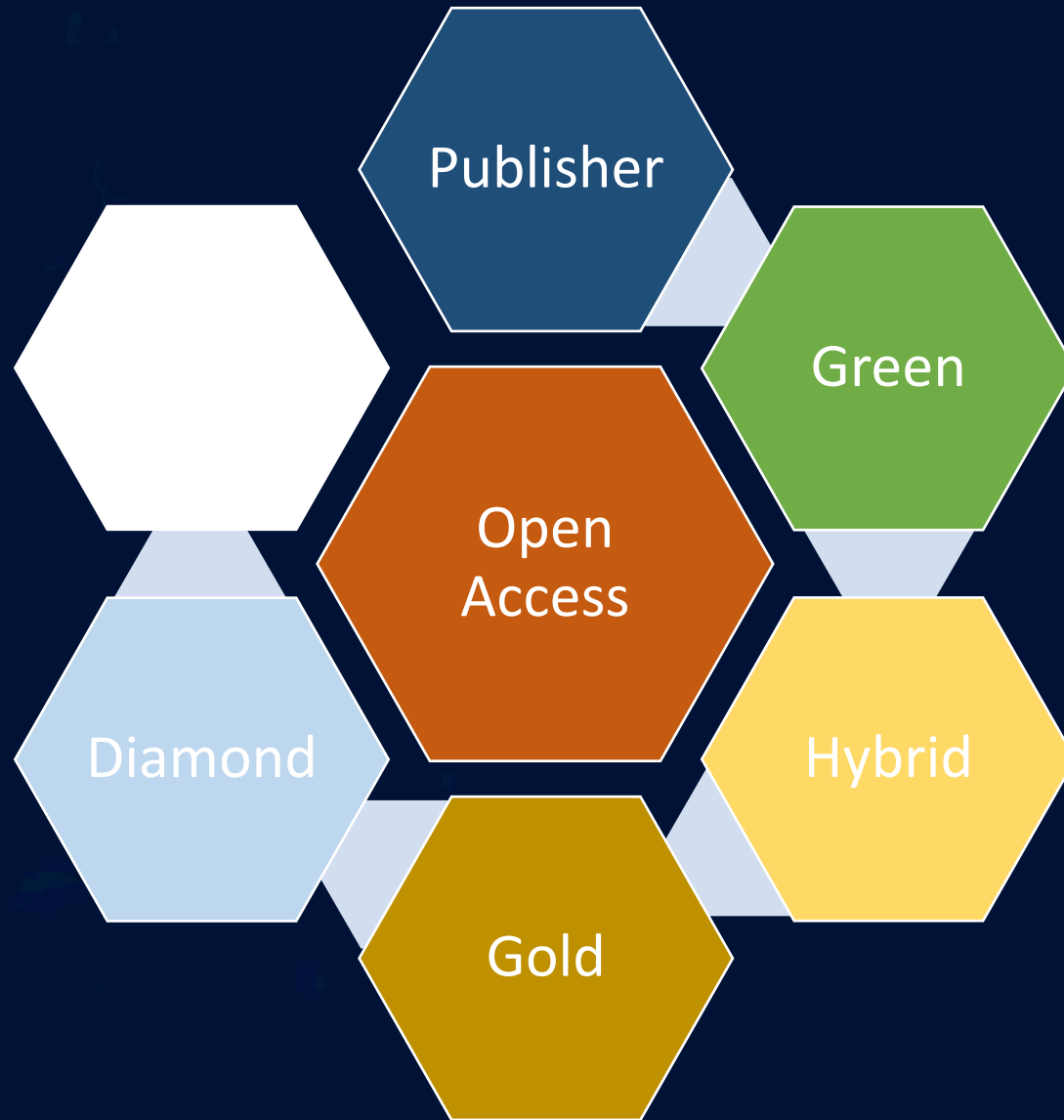


About APC

- Publishing costs = Research costs
- Make costs step publishing strategy
- Check before you submit
- Especially Gold only
- Funders allow for APC/BPC in budget
- Faculties might have a small budget
- APC discount deals library often help
- UM has no central budget (... except)

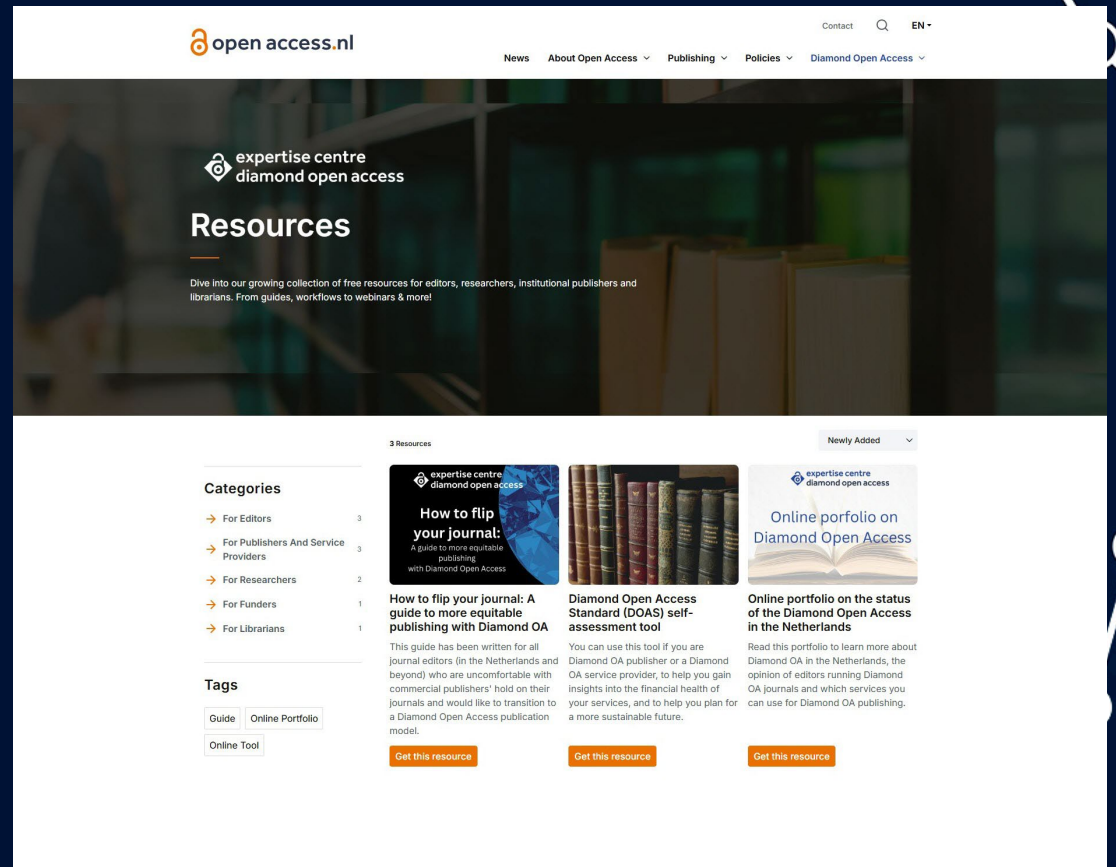

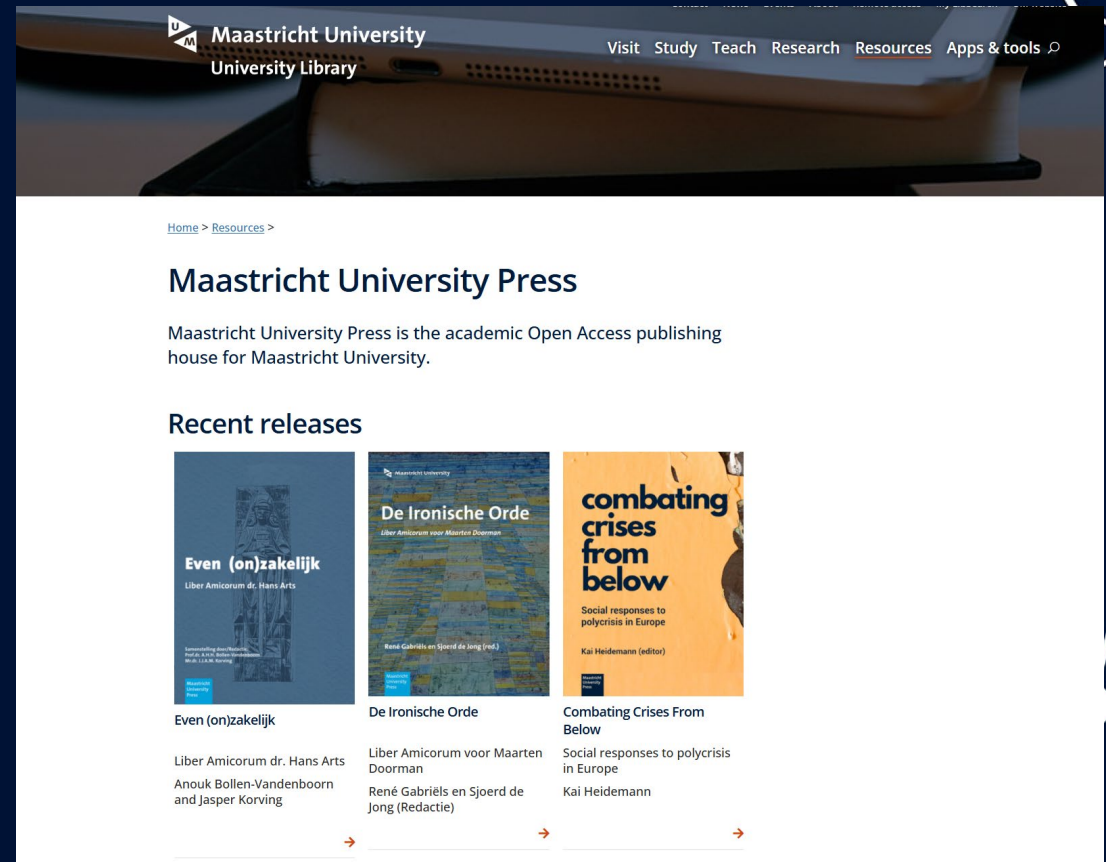

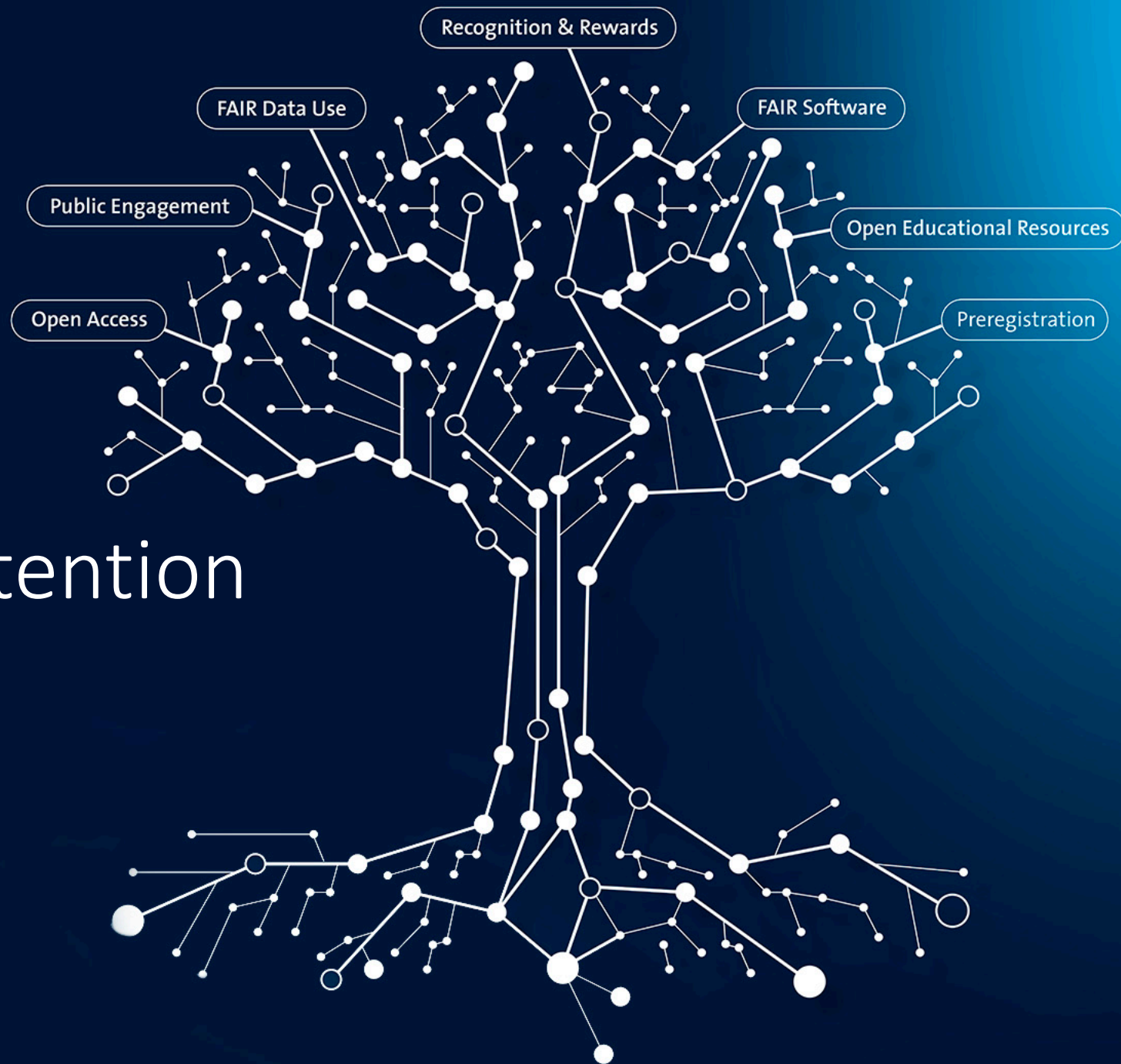
