

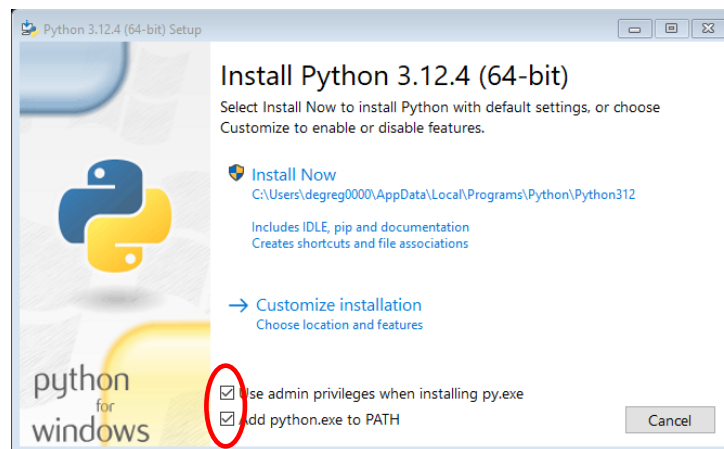
How to Use the downloader.py Script

The `downloader.py` script makes it easy to download all Hell-Date images to your computer. Follow these simple steps to get started:

1. Install Python:

Ensure that Python is installed on your computer. If not, download and install it from python.org/downloads.

Be careful to select the two checkboxes at the bottom of the installation page:



2. Extract the Archive:

Unzip the contents of the `Hell-Date.zip` archive to a folder on your computer.

3. Open a Terminal:

Navigate to the Hell-Date folder and open a terminal.

Windows:

- Right-click in the folder while holding down the **SHIFT** key.
- Click on "Open PowerShell window here".

Mac:

- Use Finder to navigate to the Utilities folder via the Go menu.
- Double-click on the Terminal application.

4. Install Dependencies:

In the terminal, install the necessary dependencies by copying and pasting the following command, then press Enter:

```
pip install -r requirements.txt
```

5. **Run the Script:**

Execute the script to download the images by entering this command in the terminal:

```
python downloader.py
```

6. **Locate Your Images:**

After the script runs, you will find a directory in your folder containing all the images from the dataset.
