IP4OS objective

To boost the **valorisation of scientific knowledge** (FAIR research outputs) by achieving **synergies between IP management and OS practices**. Thus, OS is introduced as a *modus operandi* in the European R&I landscape.

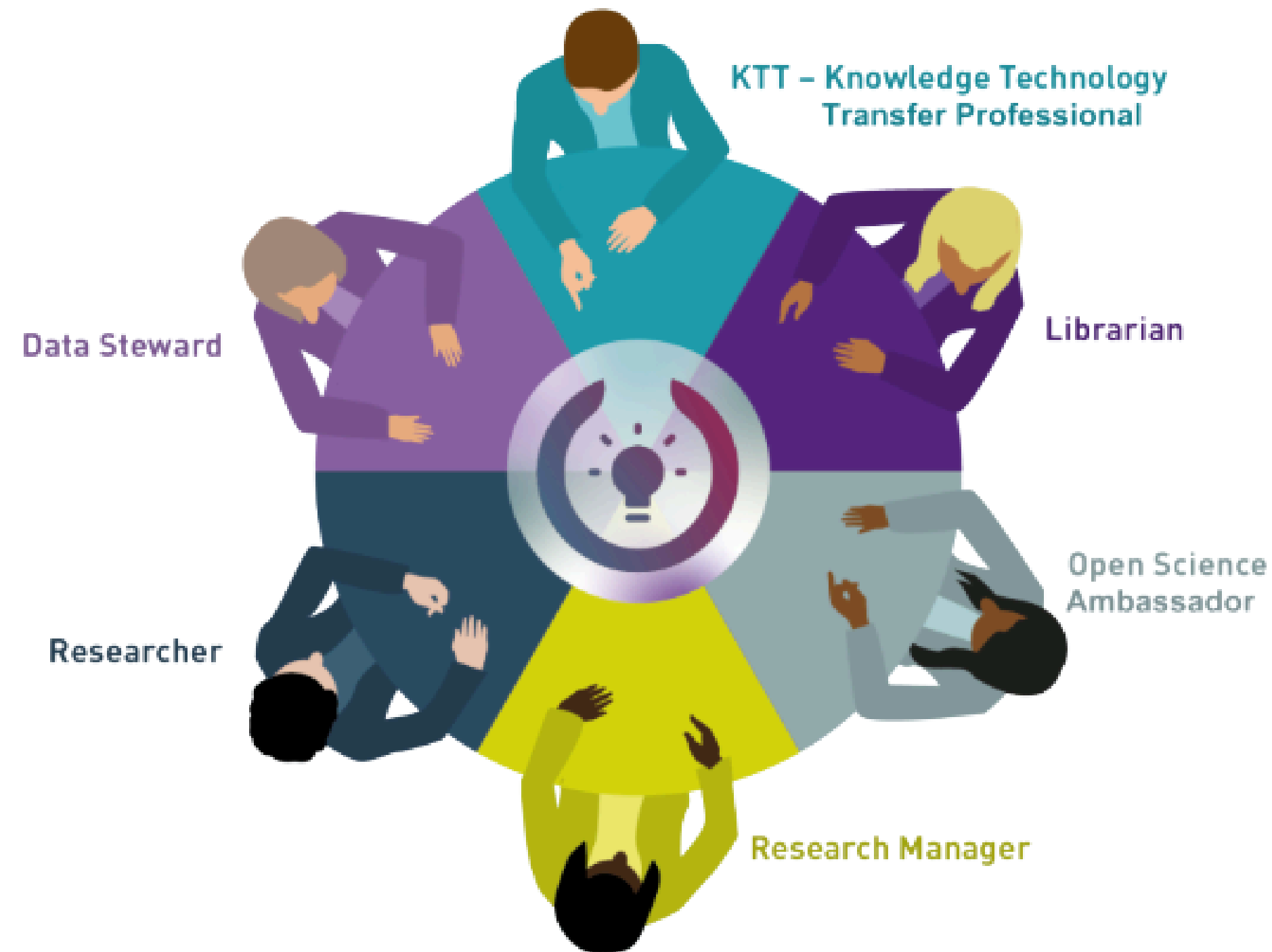

EMPOWER & TRAIN multi-professionals in RPOs with awareness, knowledge, skills, and advocacy to promote a **concerted IP-OS approach**.

- Establish and train **multi-professional teams** in RPOs in **all 27 countries**
- Act as **multipliers (train-the-trainer)** in their countries on the concerted IP-OS approach
- Independent, established committees within RPO, comprising relevant expertise from IP and OS. Publishing, data & research management, etc.
- Provide consultation within their organisations.

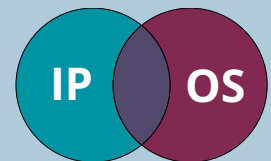
Cornerstones of a multi-professional team

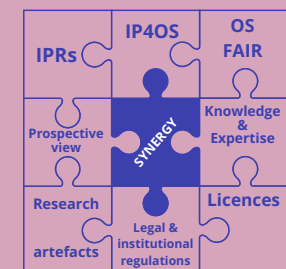
Working Mode
