



## ***Paraprososthenia liyuntongi*, a new replacement name for *Paraprososthenia lijiangensis* Y.-T. Li, 1988 (Gastropoda: Caenogastropoda: Pomatiopsidae)**

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**Abstract.** *Paraprososthenia liyuntongi* **nom. nov.** is proposed to replace *Paraprososthenia lijiangensis* Y.-T. Li, 1988, from the Sheshan Formation (Lower or Middle Pleistocene) in the Lijiang Basin, western Yunnan, China.

**Etymology.** The species is named after the original author of the taxa, Yun-Tong Li, a Chinese paleontologist tragically died in a traffic accident on 5 December 1987 while conducting geological fieldwork in Xichang, Sichuan, China (Editorial, 1988).

**Description.** see Li (1988).

**Notes.** Li (1988) described a new pomatiopsid fossil species, *Paraprososthenia lijiangensis* Y.-T. Li, 1988, from the Sheshan Formation (Lower or Middle Pleistocene) in the Lijiang Basin, western Yunnan, China. However, this name is preoccupied by *Paraprososthenia lijiangensis* Y.-Y. Liu, Y.-X. Wang & W.-Z. Zhang, 1980, an extant species likewise recorded from Lijiang, Yunnan. Therefore, the junior objective homonym must be replaced.
