ABSTRACT

Growing disparities in transport provision and spatial development have contributed to the emergence of forced car ownership (FCO) as a distinct form of transport-related disadvantage. In this study, FCO is understood as an ownership-based indicator of constrained accessibility: low-income households may acquire and maintain a private car under limited viable alternatives, rather than purely out of preference. Using nationally representative data from the China Family Panel Studies (CFPS), we describe trends in FCO over 2012–2020 and conduct multi-level logistic regression analysis on the 2020 household wave, linking household characteristics to county-level spatial conditions. The results show that although China's overall FCO rate remains lower than that reported in many developed countries, it has risen rapidly, reaching 3.90% in 2020, with a markedly higher incidence in rural areas (5.60%) than in urban areas (2.70%).
