

What is the best flap for circumferential pharyngeal reconstruction, considering risks of fistula, donor site morbidity, and mortality?

Jejunal free flap is generally preferred for minimizing fistula risk, while anterolateral thigh flaps offer lower donor site morbidity. Radial forearm free flaps are effective but have higher donor site complications.
