Description/
observations: The instrument is in very good condition and it is regularly played with an alto dulcian bocal by the owner for viola parts in 415 Hz. Tone holes appears to be remade/narrowed at a later date. There is no bocal well; the bore in the wing joint is uniform from south to north. The instrument appears unique from those seen until now. Vent hole in bell. Placement of *Ab* tone hole is lower than F tone hole, but unusually not underneath it, similar to that found on FT 34 Tuerlinckx 5-key tenoroon.
