- Testing usefulness of train-the-trainer catalogue for / by trainers



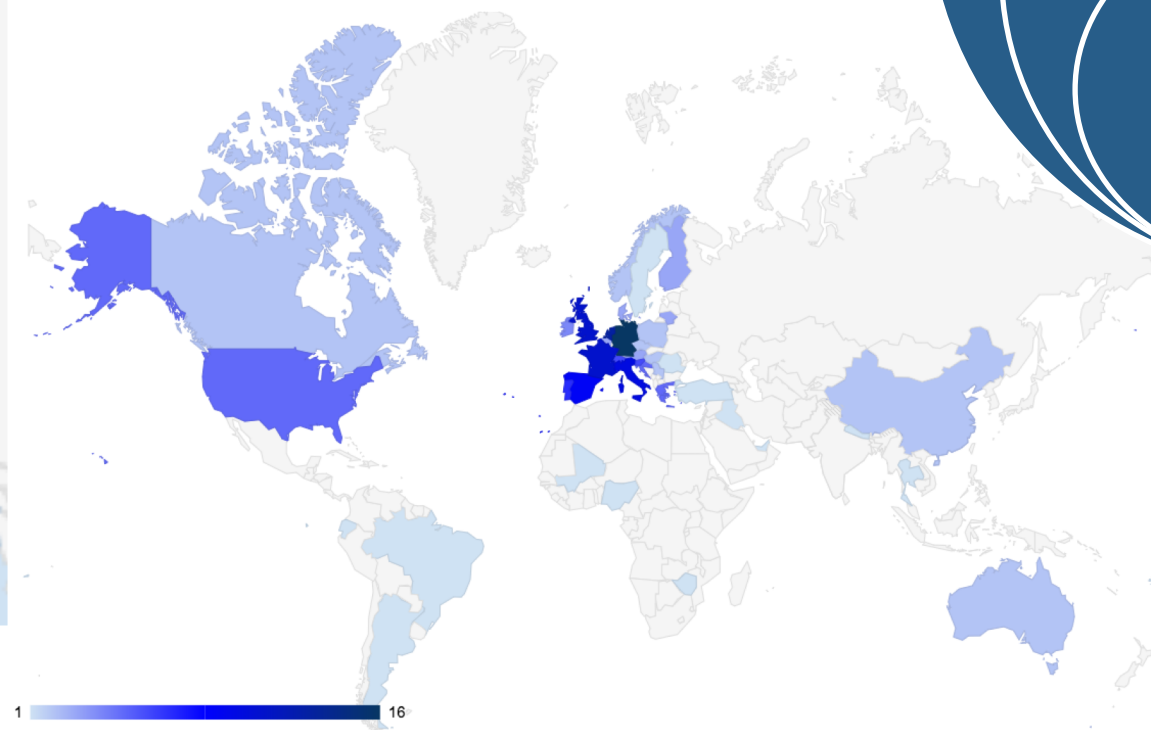
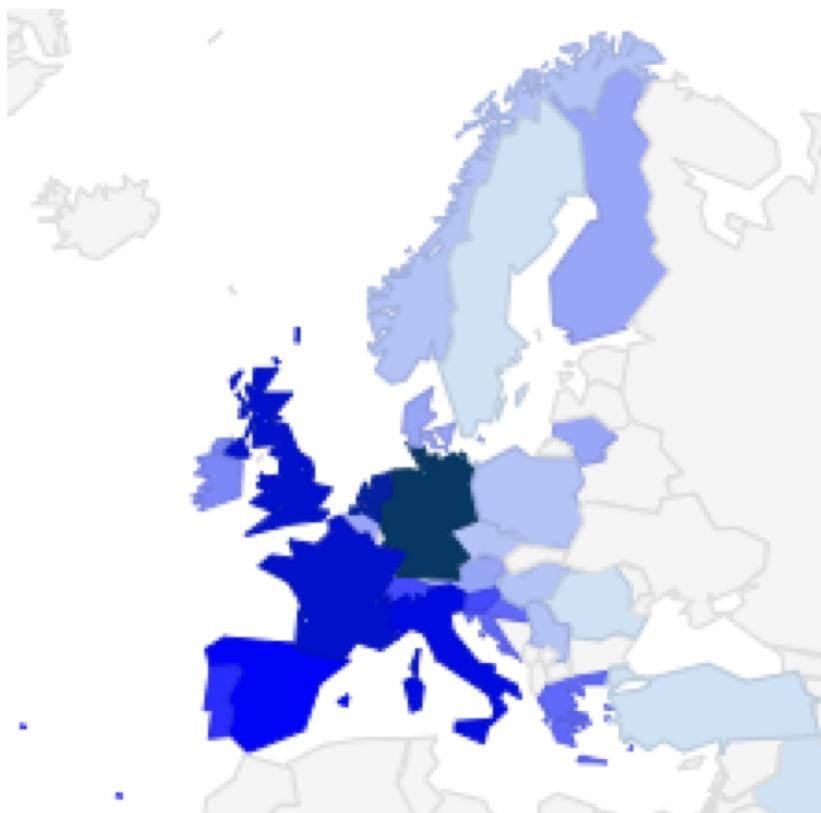
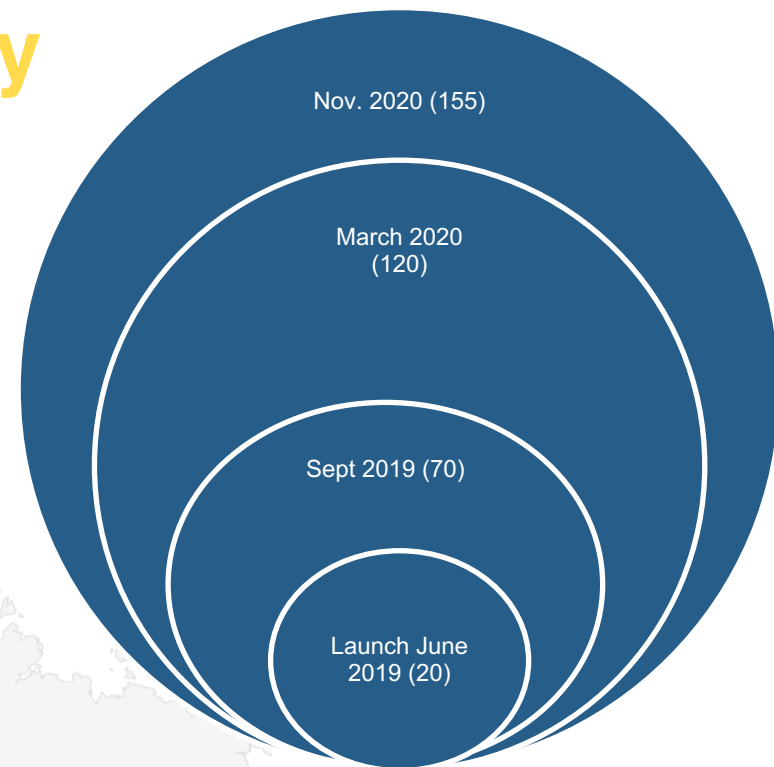

# EVALUATE Community Building 1

## What worked well:

- Trainers like the idea, opt-in, become member
- Many members
- Representatives from all disciplines in SSH
- Original goal is being reached:
  - a lot of exchange of new resources,
  - sharing experiences, ideas and expertise,
  - didactic discussions on tools and training design,
  - collaboration or participation in each other's events
- Inclusive community: open, members decide on topics, members take the floor.



# EVALUATE Community Building 2

What didn't work well (yet...):

- Only 15 to 20 attendees per call – 20% (nice small groups for discussions)

How to increase representation during community calls?

- Shared meetings with other communities?
- Host community calls during events members are already present?
- Other ideas? (in chat)





# SUSTAINABLE: SSHOC Training Community

- Join forces with CoP of training coordinators, RDA Education and Training of research data, to provide bottom up input on the needs for trainers and training:
  - FAIR training resources
  - Training Community platform for trainers
    - Support knowledge exchange, trainer directory, tools
- Align with recommendations from EOSC WG Training & Skills and EOSC FAIR WG
- Seek funding for interoperable training services
  - Community platform and Training catalogue(s)
