The Word Church, derived from the Greek word Ecclesia, is defined as "meeting" or "accepted". The root meaning of the Word "Church" is not a building, but people. Surprisingly, if you ask people which church they go to, they usually realize the building. The Romans said at 16:5, "also say hello to the congregation that will gather in their house." Paul appeals to their church in the House

– not to the public building, but to the body of believers.

The church is the body of Christ, it is considered the head. Ephesians 1:22-23 says: "he subjected the whole being to the feet of Jesus. Putting him above all being, he led the Church of the believers. The Church of the believers is the body of Christ. Christ, who makes existence whole in all respects, makes the church perfect." The body of Christ consists of all



believers in Jesus Christ, from the Feast of the Harvest (Acts Chapter 2) to the return of Christ.

The Universal Church consists of all those who have a personal connection with Jesus Christ. "After all, we were all - Jews and Greeks, slaves and freedmen, immersed in one Holy Spirit so that we could become one body. We are all filled with that same spirit" (1 Corinthians 12:13). In this verse, he says that everyone who believes in him is part of the body of Christ and has accepted the spirit of Christ as evidence. The Great Church of God is all those who receive salvation through faith in Jesus Christ.

Public associations-associations of citizens registered in the manner prescribed by law. In UZR, J. b. among them are trade unions, political parties, societies of scientists, organizations of veterans and youth, creative associations, mass movements and other associations of citizens.. People's pride, manifestation of active participation in social life, a component of democracy and the legal state, a form of life characteristic of civil society.

It is formed for the following purposes: implementation and protection of the rights and freedoms of people in the civil, economic, social and cultural spheres, strengthening their

participation in the management of state and Public Affairs, satisfying their interests in the profession and amateur sphere, developing scientific and technical and artistic creativity, maintaining public health, participation in charity work, holding events in the field of the provisions of the law on public associations in the Republic of Uzbekistan are defined in Chapter XIII of the Constitution of the Republic of Uzbekistan and in the law on public associations (February 15, 1991).

They note that the state is J. b.ensures compliance with the rights and legitimate interests of, J. b.provides equal legal opportunities for all to participate in the. State bodies and officials J. b. activities, J. b.NIN is not allowed to interfere in the activities of state bodies and officials.

The laws of the Republic of Uzbekistan on public associations will consist of this law, which determines the basics of the legal status of Public Associations, the law of the Republic of Karakalpakstan on public associations, other legislative acts of the Republic of Uzbekistan.

Public associations are civil, political, economic, social and cultural, realization and protection of rights and freedoms; development of citizen activity and initiative, their participation in the management of state and Public Affairs; satisfaction



of professional and amateur interests; development of scientific, technical and artistic creativity; improvement of the population-preservation of Health, participation in charitable activities; cultural-educational, fizkultura-carrying out health-improving and sports activities; protection of nature, monuments of history and culture; patriotic and humanitarian education; expansion of inter-Republican and international relations, strengthening peace and friendship between peoples; it is formed in order to carry out other activities that are not prohibited by law.

According to Article 56 of the Constitution of the Republic of Uzbekistan, trade unions, societies of scientists, women's, veterans and youth organizations, creative unions, mass movements and other associations of citizens are recognized as public associations.

The Constitution of the Republic of Uzbekistan guarantees public associations the opportunity to fulfill the main goals and objectives stipulated by its statutes. This guarantee serves as a legal basis for the realization of the rights of citizens to voluntary association.

The legal basis of Public Associations was created in the Republic of Uzbekistan-Chapter XIII of the Constitution and the right of

citizens to participate in the management of society and the state (Article 32), Union of trade unions, political parties, Public Associations, participation in mass movements (Article 34) are guaranteed
