What are persistent identifiers?

A persistent identifier is a long-lasting reference to a digital resource. An identifier is a label which gives a unique name to an entity: a person, place, or thing. More than the object itself, PIDs are connected to metadata describing an object.



- Provides better visibility
- Allows better quality metrics



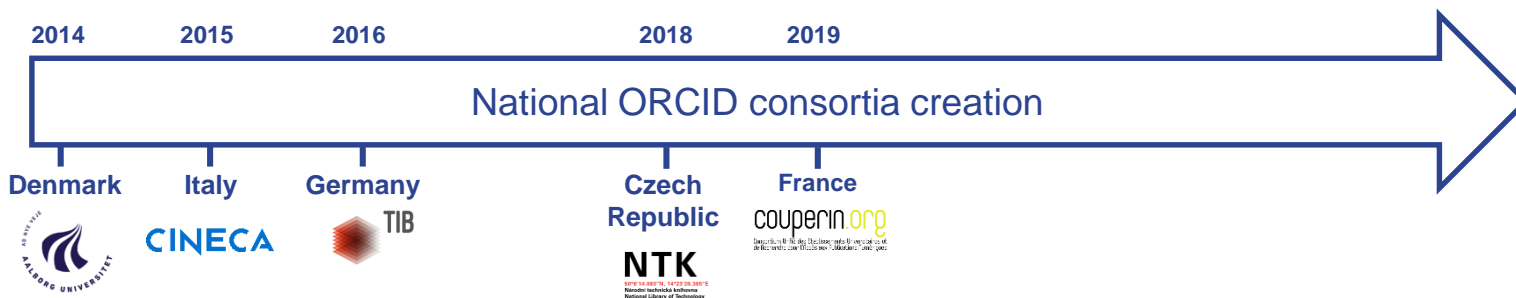

Examples of national and international funder policies

Ask for a PID (such as ORCID)

Recommend ORCID

Publishers policies

Many publishers require authors to have an ORCID. For instance 1100 Wiley journals require corresponding authors to register an ORCID.

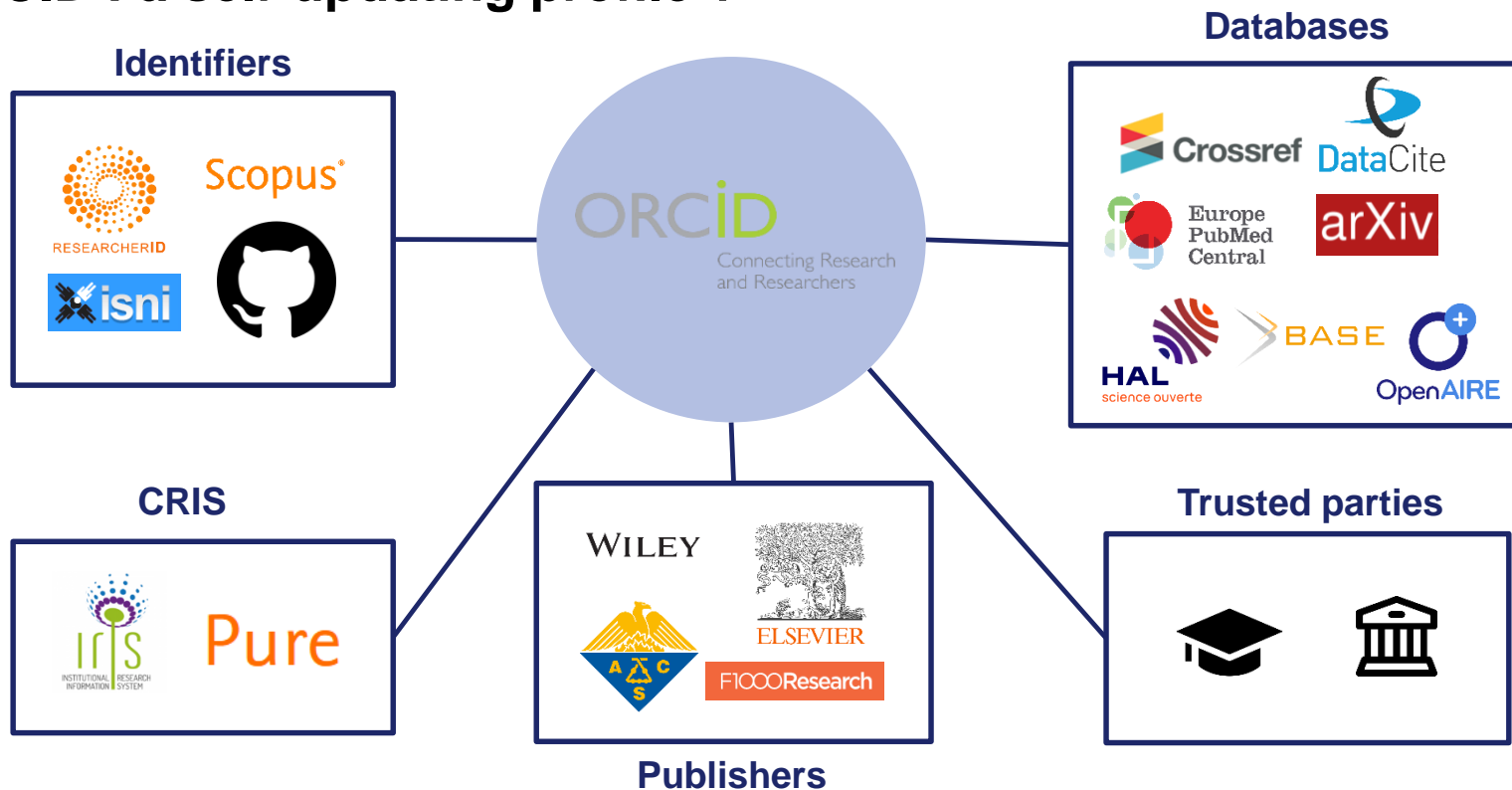
Some publishers allow researchers to add an ORCID to import peer review data to their ORCID profile (e. g. : ACS, F1000...)

Create your ORCID

Go to orcid.org and click **SIGN IN/REGISTER** to create an account. Then click on « Register now » if you do not yet have an ORCID.

- **Primary email** : Prefer your institutional email. You can change it if you change institution
- **Additionnal email** : It may be usefull for recovering your password. It can be hidden in your profile (see [visibility seeting](#))

After this step ORCID checks whether you already have an ORCID record.

If your institution has a CRIS (Current Research Information System) linked to ORCID, you may be able to create your ORCID directly from the CRIS

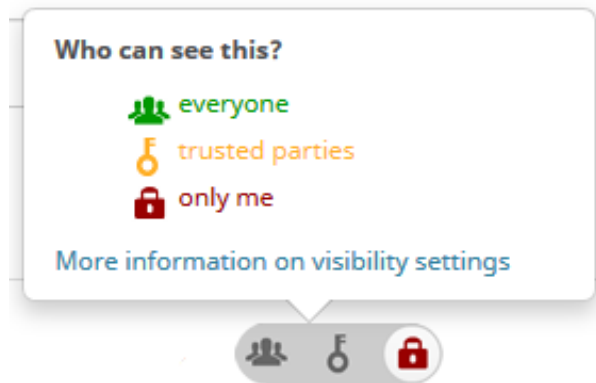

- **Published names** : it will appear in bold at the top of your profile
- **Also known as** : other ways to name you (other names, pseudonyms, transliterations, names with initials...)
- **Biography** : free text field (max 5000 char.)

Identifying informations

This information is used to distinguish you from your homonyms.

- **Emails:** here you can edit and check your main and additional emails
- **Websites & social links:**
 - Personal pages (on insitutional website)
 - Academic and professional social networks (ResearchGate, Academia, LinkedIn...)
 - Blogs or personal websites
- **Other Ids :** You cannot add a PID manually, you must synchronise it with an authentication process (see [search & link](#))
- **Keywords :** add your expertise fields
- **Countries :** Add your country

ORCID uses two registers for organisations : [ROR](#) and [Ringgold](#). Prefer ROR which is open. If you use registry, city and country will displayed automatically.

If you can't find your organisation in the list you can add it manually.

You can also add your department, role and start/end dates. This informations aren't mandatory but are recommended.

If your institution has a CRIS linked to ORCID, you can fill in the employment automatically with the CRIS data.

For all these categories, the form is the same as for employments. You have to fill in some compulsory information about organisations, and some optional informations

- **Education** : add your degree (Masters, PhD)

In the works section you can add many types of research products : publication, conference, patent, data set, softwares, DMP...



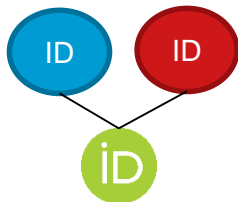
Find sources

The search & link service allows you to import data from several sources : Some of them have a very specific scope (geographical, thematic, typological...), and will therefore not be useful to all researchers.



Find your data

For some sources all you need to do is to fill in or set an author ID (link to your publications). For others sources you will have to manually select your publications after a search based on your name



Update

Some sources only allow a semi-automatic import. You will need to manually push the publication to your ORCID profile. Others provides a synchronization via PIDs. In this case your publications list will be automatically update
