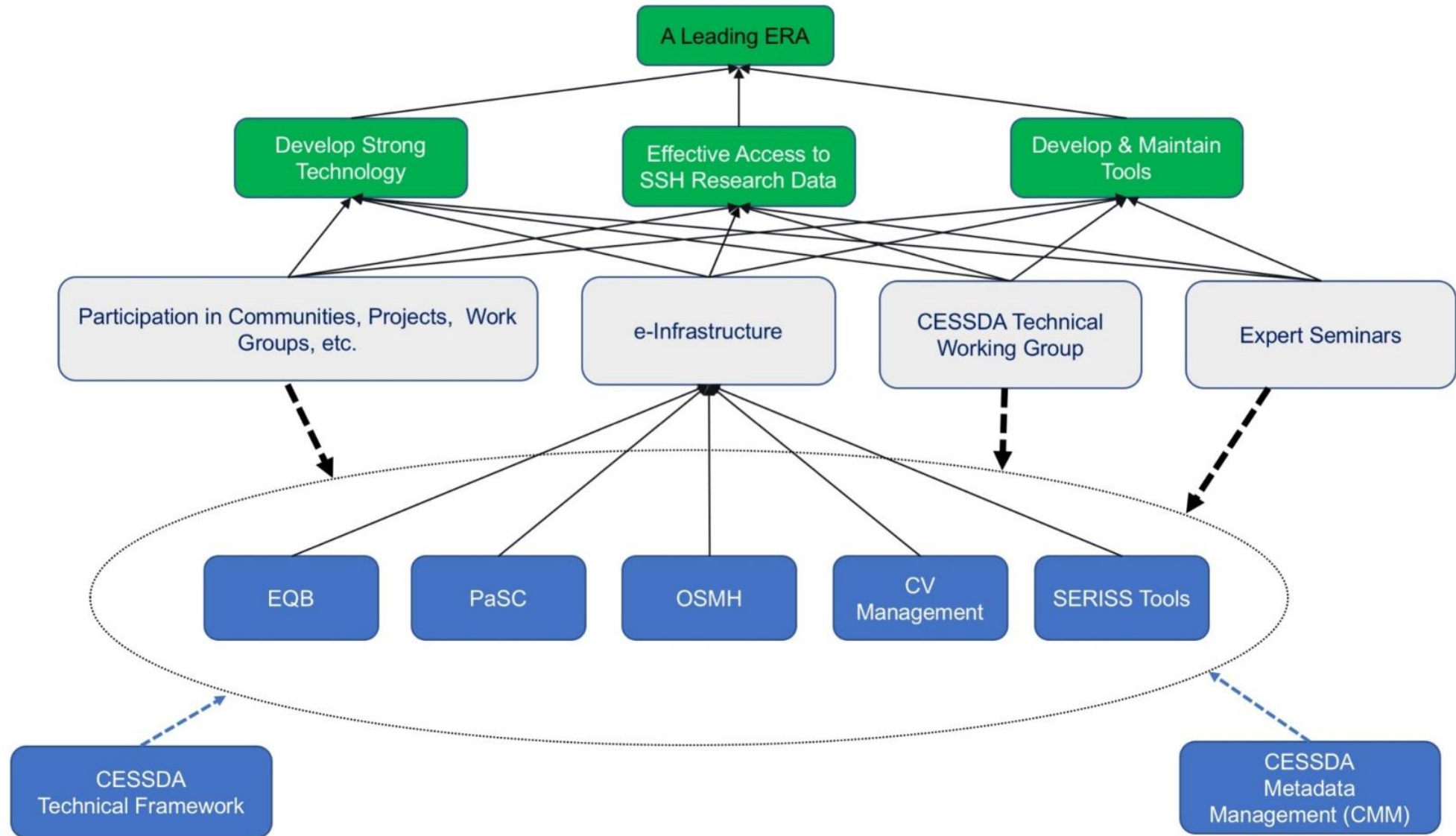


About CESSDA

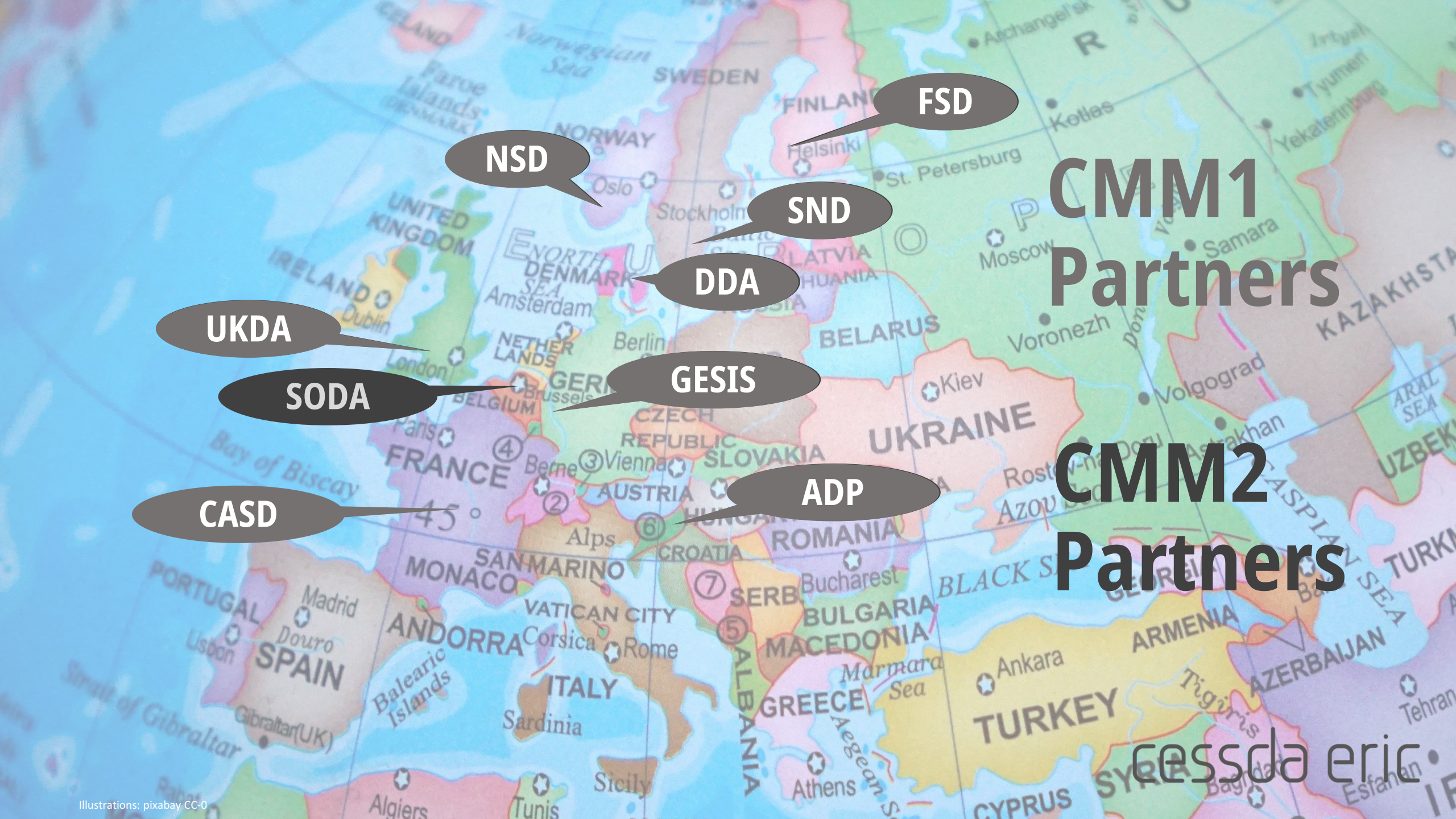

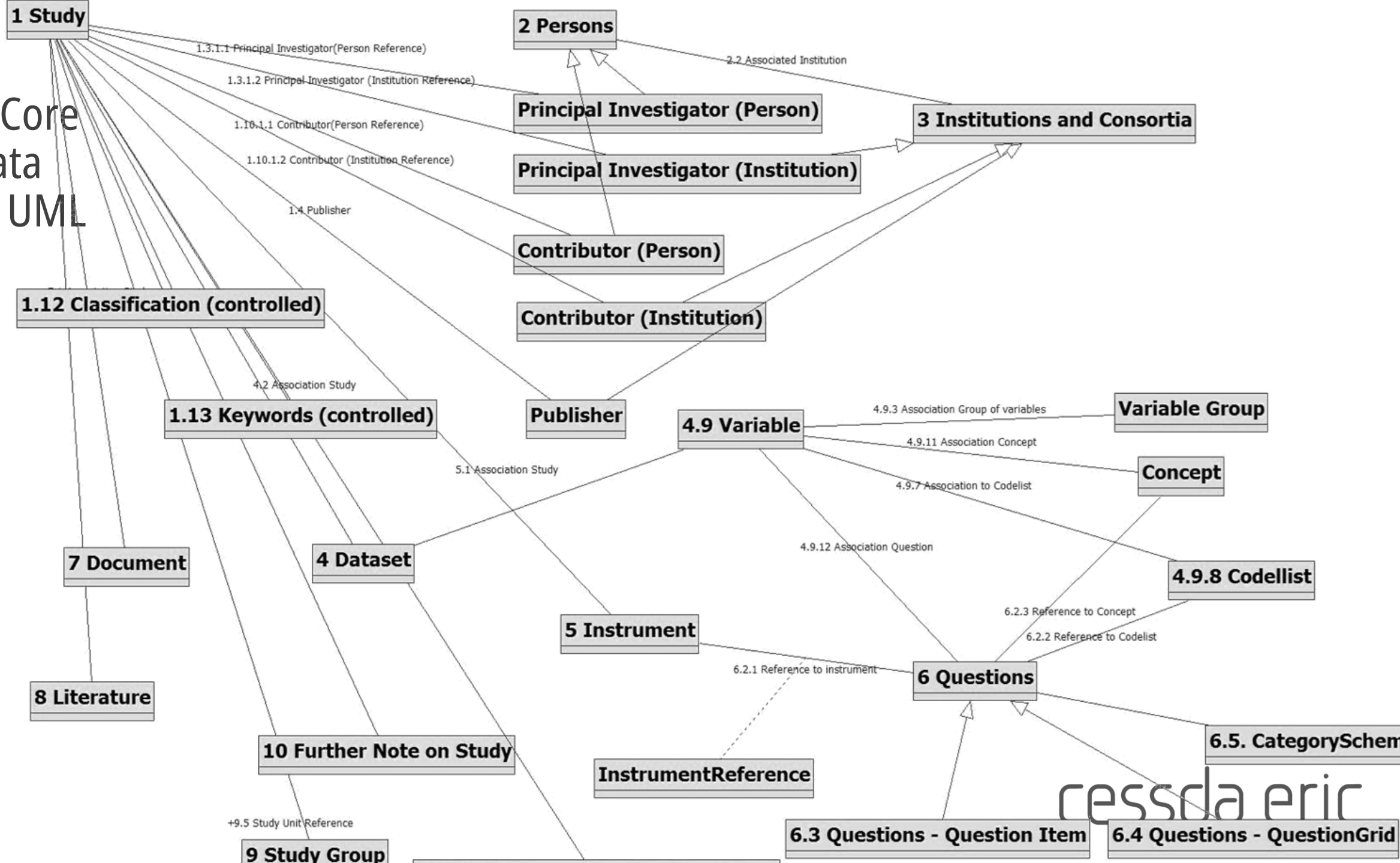

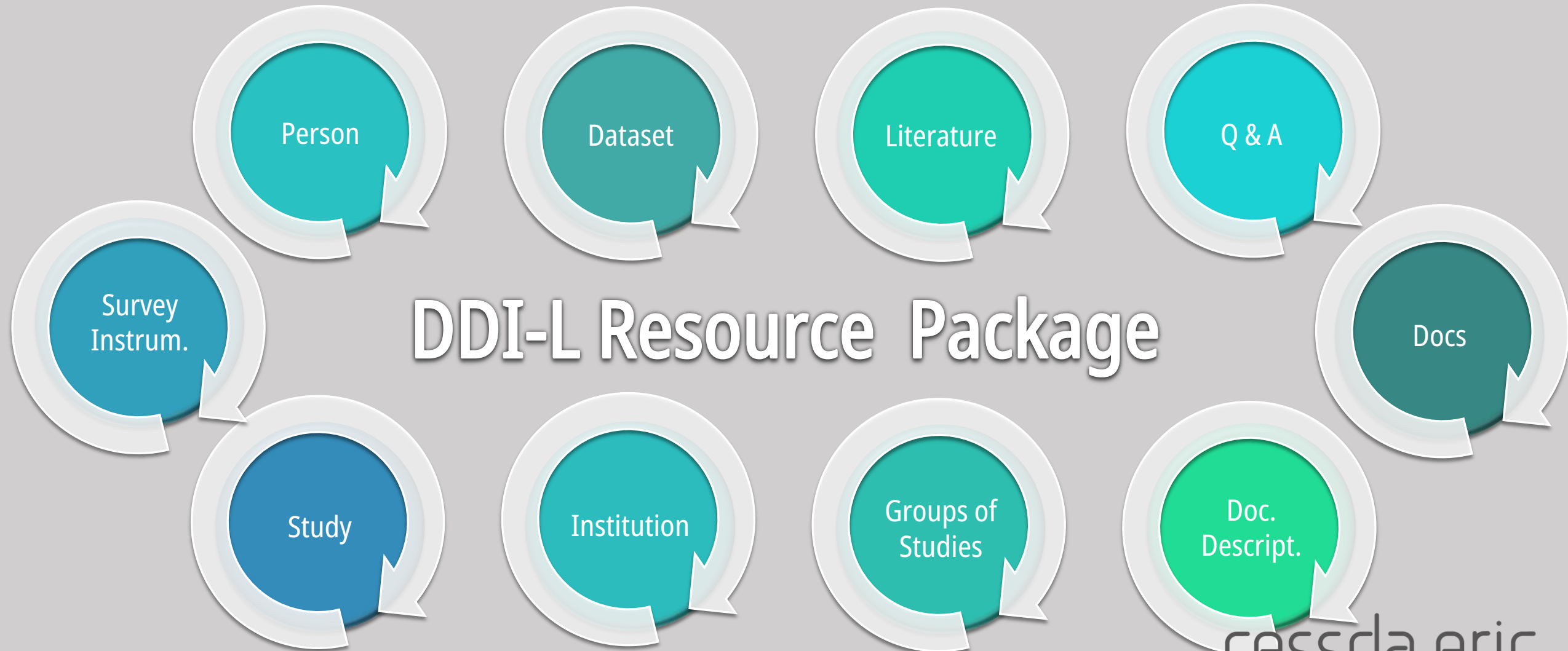

- For more extensive metadata: DDI4

Access rights harmonization and description

CESSDA Metadata group (“Metadata Office”)

- To monitor, maintain and manage CMM model and other metadata issues (DDI4 implementation, RDA developments, EoSC compatibility...)
