Description	<p>This document is the proof of having delivered 'D2.4 ClairCity Annual Conference – Hungary'. The project obtained consent of participants to take and publish pictures and names.</p> <p>The ClairCity Consortium Meeting (just for project partners) and Annual Conference (open to the public) took place on 22-24 May in Szentendre, Hungary. The event was hosted by the consortium partner the Regional Environmental Center (REC) at their premises (Ady Endre ut 9-11, 2000 Szentendre) and was a 'success' in our assessment and judging from the external participants' feedback. Not only the ClairCity Consortium Partners participated -in some cases with several delegates each- but also the ClairCity External Advisory Board was almost fully represented. Further, ClairCity Associates, lecturers and other external guests joined the public part of the event.
