


Key takeaways from the annual report

- The event series goes decentral & multilingual
 - Australia
 - Czechia
 - ...
- The COVID-19 pandemic
 - Modified activities planned in Czechia, Ireland, Finland
 - Canceled events in Ghana, Germany, India
 - Postponed events in Haiti, Ghana
 - Triggered WikiProject COVID-19, with lots of WikiCite in it
- The ecosystem around WikiCite is evolving

Akce podpořená z grantu [WikiCite Satellite Events](#) původně měla trvat celý víkend a mělo se ji zúčastnit více než 15 knihovníků i wikipedistů. Bohužel zasáhl koronavirus, a tak jsme se sešli pouze na půlden a v poměru omezeného počtu. I tak se naštěstí podařilo probrat mnoho z původně plánovaných témat a účastníci odjížděli s pocitem, že se podařilo odstartovat něco nového a významného na poli knihovnických dat.



 - Lay the foundations for building a repository of all Wikimedia references as structured data in Wikidata
 - Design data models and technology to improve the coverage, quality, standards-compliance and machine-readability of citations and source metadata in Wikipedia, Wikidata and other Wikimedia projects



All bibliographic data stays in Wikidata	All bibliographic data stays in Wikidata, but in a dedicated namespace with a dedicated data model (similar to lexemes)	Bibliographic data (other than what's considered notable in Wikidata) moves to an official Wikimedia sister project, powered by Wikibase, and tightly integrated with other Wikimedia projects.	Bibliographic data is handled and curated through a federation of specialized wikibases, with no central hub or data store.



6. avoiding thinking about how big the challenge is






Subject affiliation
