

CLARIAH-DE: Research Infrastructure for the Humanities

What is CLARIAH-DE?

CLARIAH-DE is a project for the merger of CLARIN-D and DARIAH-DE into a joint digital research infrastructure:

- CLARIN-D is the German part of the European initiative Common Language Resources and Technology Infrastructure (CLARIN). As a European Research Infrastructure Consortium (ERIC), CLARIN is part of a network of twenty countries and further partners.
- DARIAH-DE is the German partner of the Digital Research Infrastructure for the Arts and Humanities (DARIAH-EU). With 19 countries and further partners, DARIAH is also an ERIC on the European level.

Via CLARIN-D and DARIAH-DE, CLARIAH-DE is tightly linked with infrastructure facilities on the European level, as well as with their technologies and further developments.

Goals

- Integration of the services provided by CLARIN-D and DARIAH-DE
- FAIR-oriented linkage of complex digital tools, services and databases, so that they are together usable in order to answer concrete – and new – research questions
- Interconnection of research communities with regard to research co-operations in the humanities, cultural studies and social studies in Germany and Europe
- Structure-building contribution to the humanities with regard to the development of a national research data infrastructure (NFDI)


Offers for researchers

WP 1 Research Data, Standards and Procedures

Lead: Berlin-Brandenburg Academy of Sciences and Humanities

Focus: Unification and harmonisation of standards and procedures for the creation, processing and archiving of data and tools

WP 2 Tools and Virtual Research Environments

Lead: Institute of Linguistics and Literary Studies, Technical University of Darmstadt

Focus: Interconnection of large tools and virtual research environments of the two research infrastructures

WP 3 Skills Training and Promotion of Junior Researchers

Lead: Chair of Computational Philology and Modern German Literary History, Julius Maximilians University of Würzburg

Focus: Transferring competences to junior researchers, compiling teaching and learning material, organisation of workshops

WP 4 Technical Integration and Coordination of Technical Developments

Lead: Institute of Computer Science, Department of Natural Language Processing, Leipzig University

Focus: Merging technologies, tools, services and processes of both research infrastructures

WP 5 Community Engagement: Outreach/Dissemination and Liaison

Lead: Department of General and Computational Linguistics, University of Tübingen

Focus: Development of a corporate identity, online presence and public image

WP 6 Organisational Infrastructure/Administrative Offices

Lead: Göttingen State and University Library

Focus: Overall coordination of CLARIAH-DE, development of the governance, help desk, European co-operation of the project
