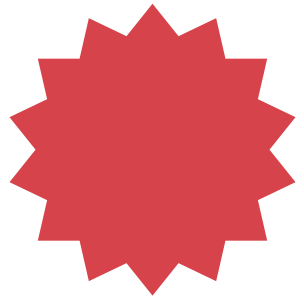

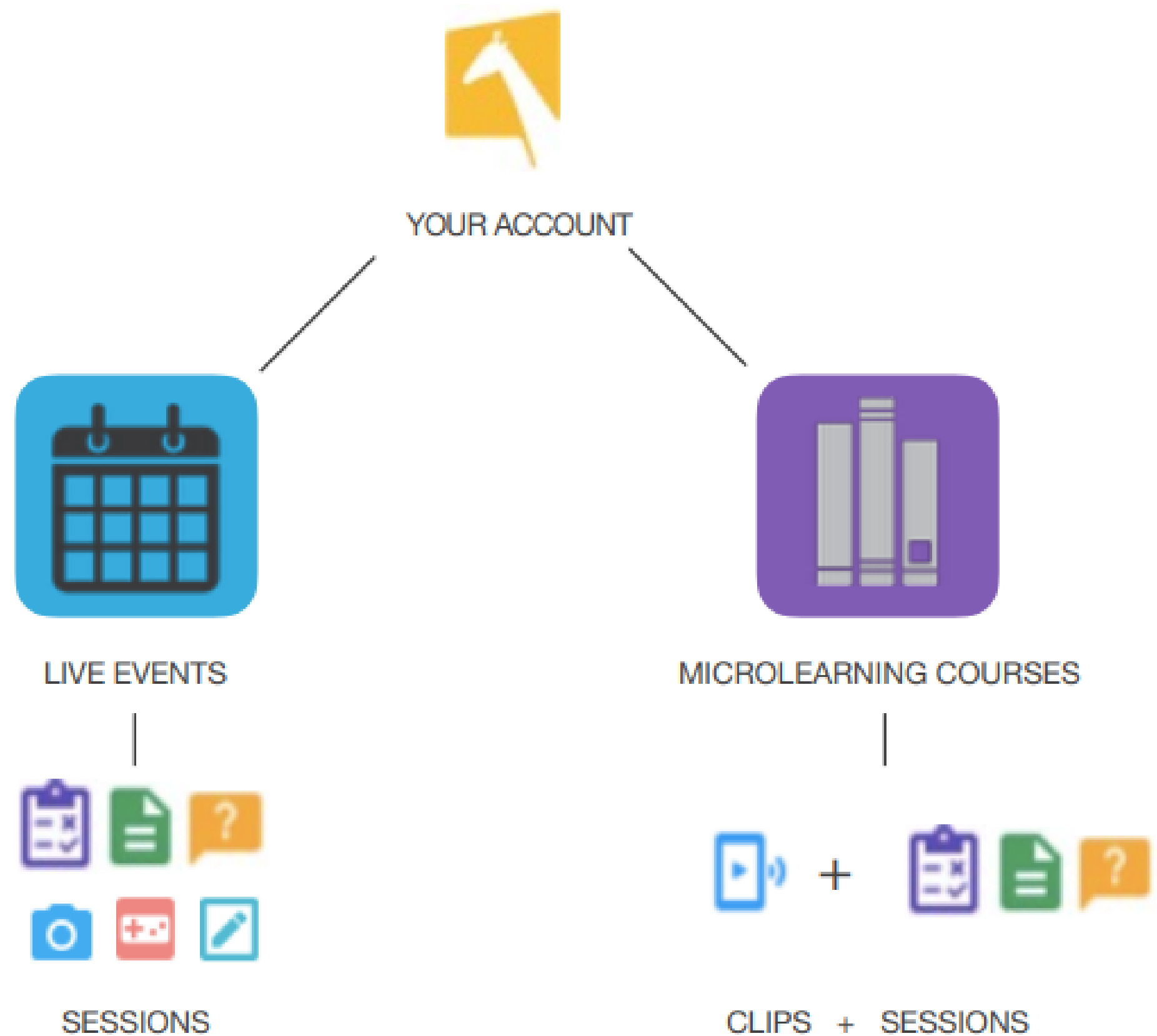

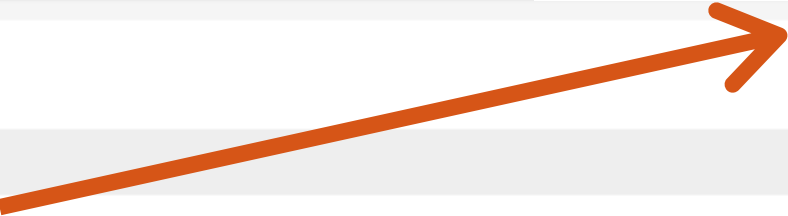

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What is Present Continuous Tense?

The present continuous (also called present progressive) is a verb tense which is used to show that an ongoing action is happening now, either at the moment of speech or now in a larger sense. The present continuous can also be used to show that an action is going to take place in the near future.

The Structures of Present Continuous/Progressive Tense

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The present continuous of any verb is composed of two parts - the present tense of the verb to be + the present participle of the main verb. (The form of the present participle is: base+ing, e.g. talking, playing, moving, smiling).

Correct answer: D

**Explanation:** He is watering the flower. The sentence has the meaning "he is watering flowers". In the present continuous tense, there is an auxiliary verb, which is 'be' (is, am, are). To be able to determine "is, am, are" that is used, it must be determined again with the subject used.

Because in this sentence the subject is "He", the "be" is used is "is". Other subjects using 'is' are 'she' and 'it'. Please note that after 'is, am, are', a verb must be followed with the -ing affix.
