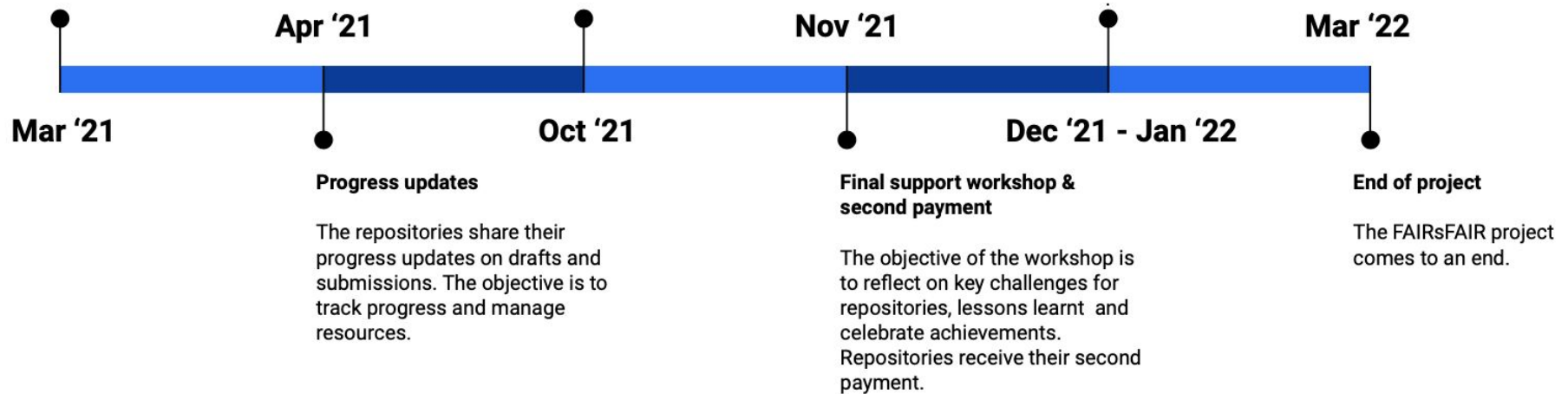
The objective is to submit application to CoreTrustSeal by March 2021.

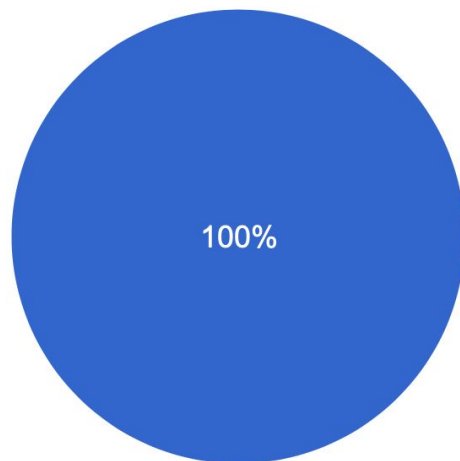
# Sustainability: how to foster your and our initial engagement?

- coordination of efforts → greater contribution, e.g. in the EOSC
- FAIRsFAIR support (and other sources such as SSHOC, EOSC Nordic!) has the potential to be extended and expanded through the development of a community of Trustworthy Digital Repositories (TDRs)
- advocating and exploring the idea of a network of sustainable European FAIR-enabling TDRs (cross-disciplinary and cross-border function)
- not to build from scratch; take advantage of existing community efforts

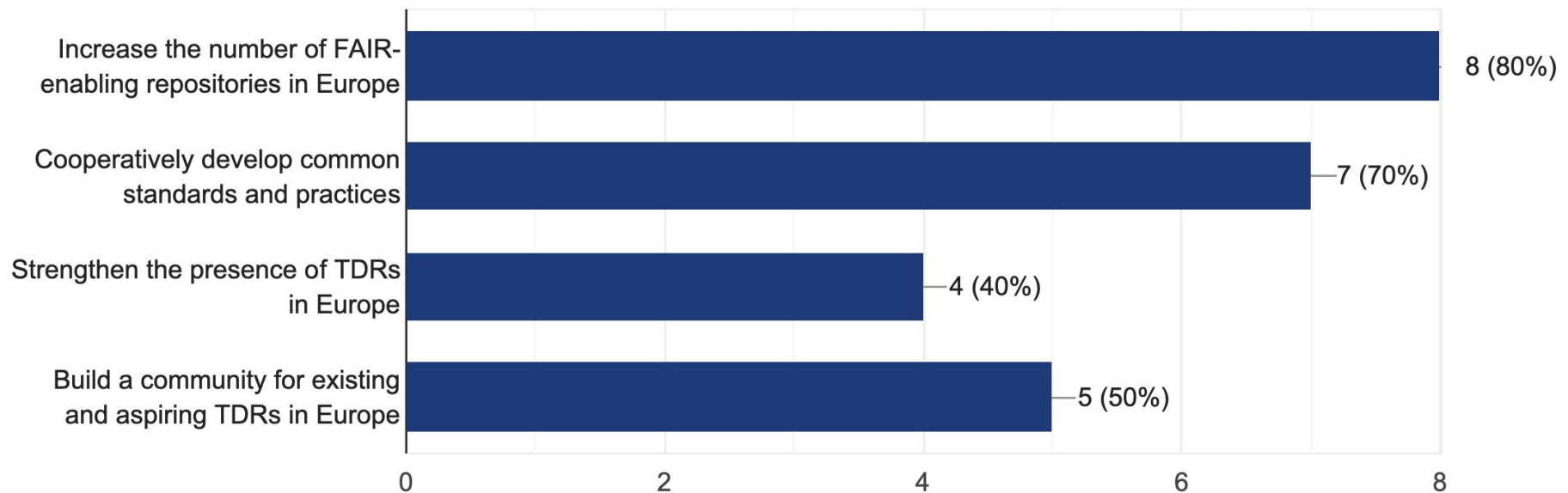

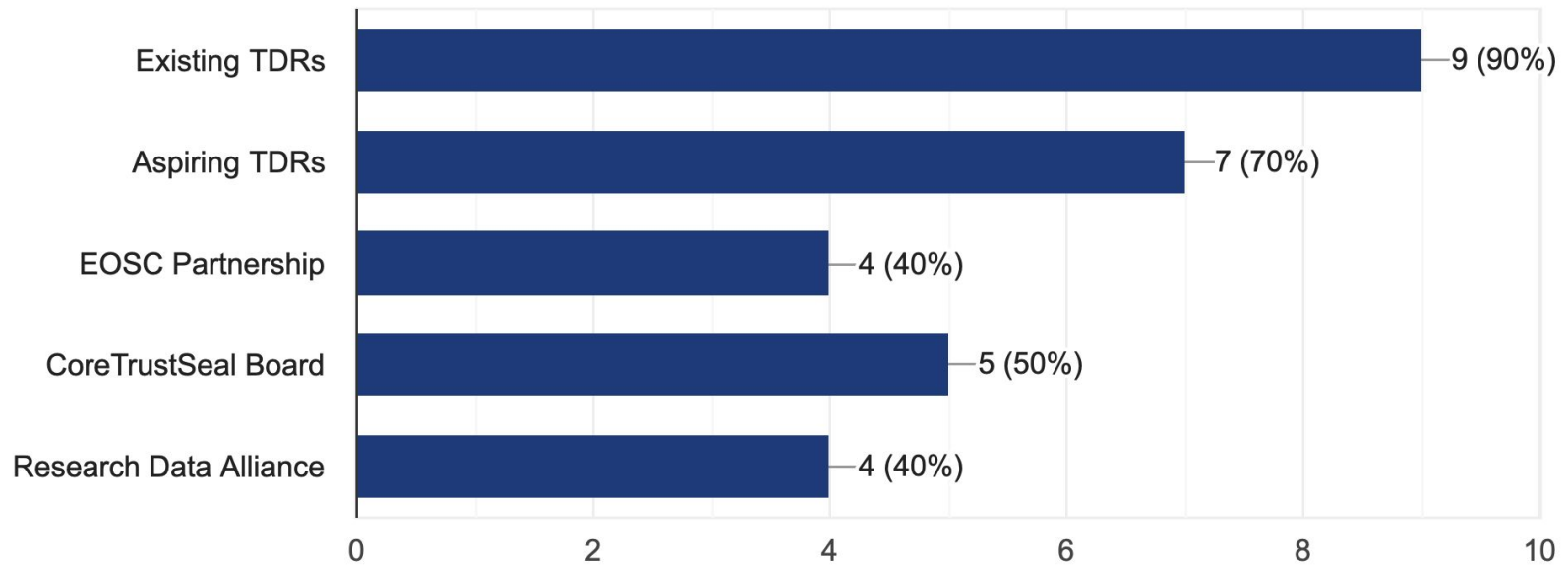

# Network of FAIR-enabling Trustworthy Digital Repositories (TDRs)

## Scope Now



- initial network of existing and aspiring Trustworthy Digital **Repositories** (TDRs)
- increase the number of FAIR-enabling TDRs
- initial focus on **Europe** and **EOSC**

## Scope Later



- wider network of existing and aspiring trustworthy **data services**
- increase the number of FAIR-enabling trustworthy data services
- focus reach **beyond Europe** on other federated research (meta)data infrastructures

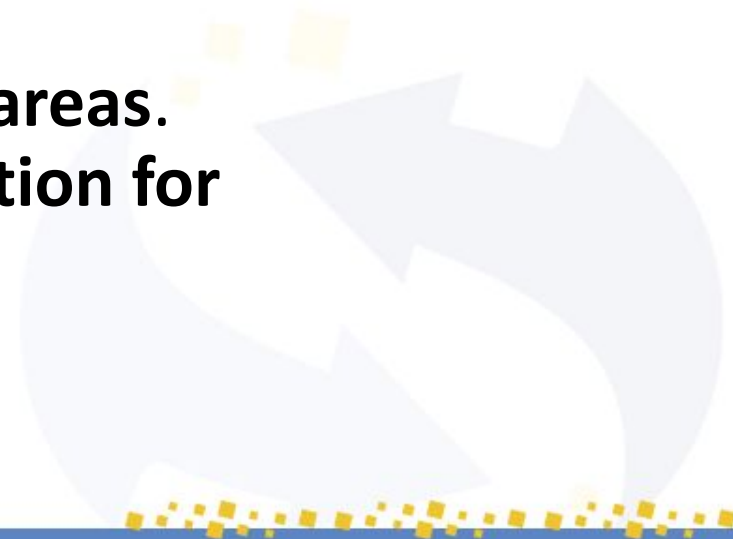

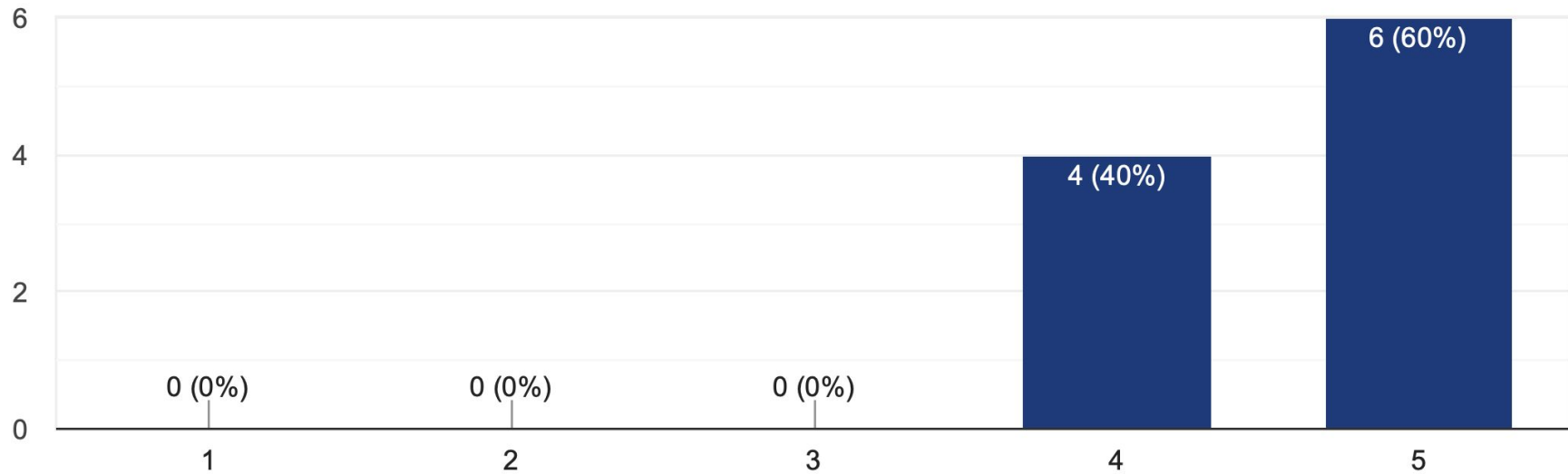
## What were your expectations before joining the support programme?

- Help quickly submit an **application for certification**.

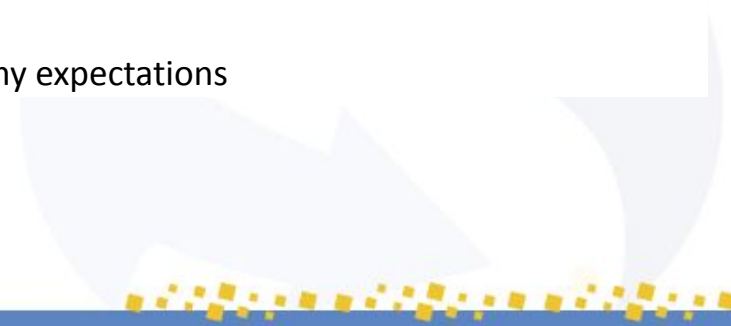


## How did the programme live up to these expectations?
