proved to be yet the most popular topics.



# How these activities fit into the MSP Rolling Plan for ICT Standardisation



**Key Enablers and Security** (28 Proposals). 5G, Cybersecurity and Artificial Intelligence, Quantum Technologies were the topics which received the most relevant share of the total funding.



**Societal Challenges** (1 Proposal). "Safety, Transparency & Due Process Online" was the only funded topic.



**Innovation for the DSM** (1 Proposal). The only funded proposal revolves around the "Metaverse including CitiVerse".



**Sustainable Growth** (4 Proposals) is a priority for the EU. The funded proposals show the standardisation efforts in areas such as Circular Economy including DPP, Smart Cities, ICT Environmental Impact and Robotics & Autonomous Systems.
