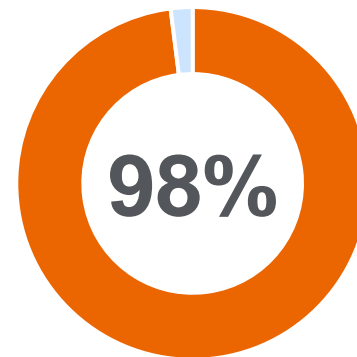

Finding sources

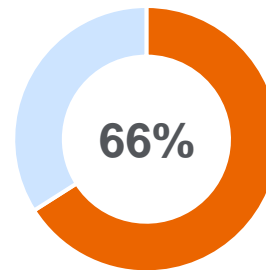
Nearly all students' navigation of the complex campus information landscape is narrow in scope

Efficiency

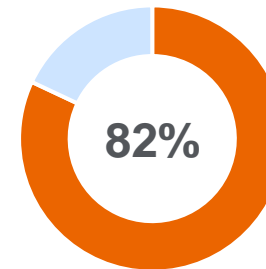
Most students use a risk-averse and consistent strategy and rely on a "tried and true approach"

Education 5.0 – futuristic term or a new reality

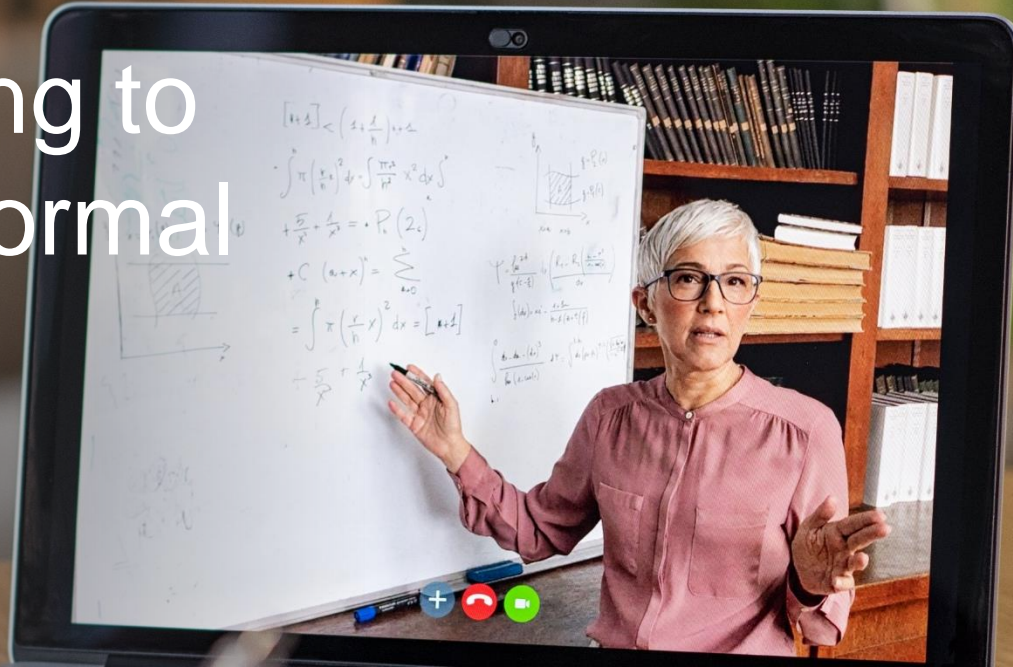
- Post-pandemic world – life shifted to digital

The ultimate goal of Education 5.0 is to create a more efficient, effective, and equitable education system that can adapt to the changing needs of the society.

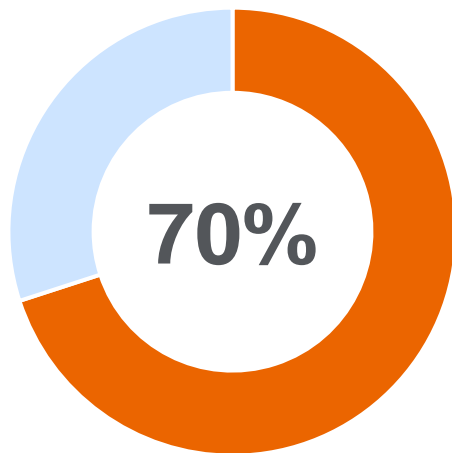

Librarians believe their preference for book-based content to support teaching and learning, which changed due to the COVID-19 pandemic, is permanent

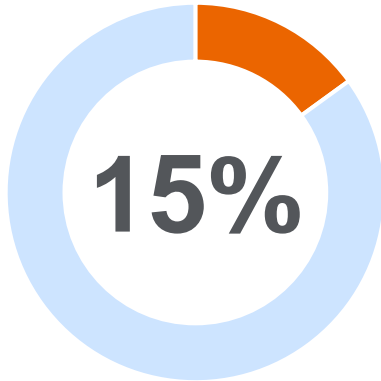

Using books drives impact

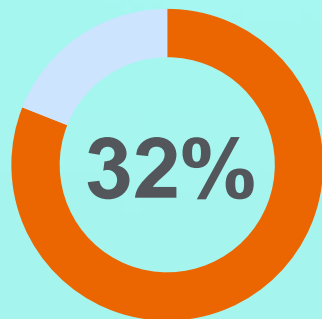


Higher *Field-Weighted Citation Impact* when an article references a book at least once

contains books references



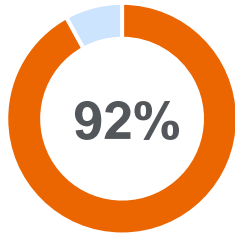

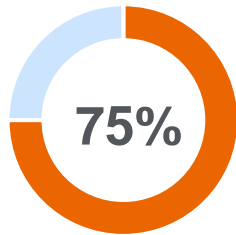


You hold the keys to success
