

Structure, operations



CzechELib modus operandi

- bottom-up approach
 - nominations from members needed to start any process
 - certain number of institutions (threshold) is required/needed so it makes sense to operate on a consortial level (regardless of the type of agreement)
- CzechELib threshold: 3+ rule CzechELib facilitates state/cofunding for e-resources
- currently secured till end of 2027



About CzechELib:

Established in 2017, department of National Library of Technology (ie under Ministry of Education)

Year 2023:

- **130** member institutions
- Contracts with **59** publishers
- 14 transformative Read & Publish agreements covering cca 1 800 articles

R&D: institutions and people



Most important institutions involved in R&D (with status of Research organization)

- 26 public universities
- Academy of Sciences: over 51 research institutes
- a few state research institutes, hospitals, small private ones
- No. of researchers-employees (census data):
 - ~ 66 thousand
- No. of students (CzechELib data, annual reports):
 - ~ 150 thousands in STEM
 - ~ 150 thousands in SSH







Transformative Agreements


A contract negotiated between institutions (libraries, national and regional consortia) and publishers

transforms the business model from subscription (pay to read) to one (pay to read & publish) in which publishers are remunerated a fair price for their OA publishing services.

"the devil/is in the details"


Ambition is the transition from subscription to Gold OA model

From individual subscriptions to Big Deals



Hybrid publishing has created second, unmonitored channel of income for publishers ("double dipping")




Transformative agreements try to gain control over costs in "hybrid" titles







Subscription costs are converted to APCs




Costs and workflow - transition to individual articles





TAs in the World as of Oct 2023




Transformative agreements in Europe, ESAC Reg. Nov 2023

Eligibility criteria - for authors



- 1. My institution is included in the agreement
- 2. I'm the corresponding (submitting) author (please, use your institutional email)
- 3. The journal is listed as eligible
- 4. The article type & acceptance date are OK
- 5. Very important: for capped agreements my institution still has enough "tokens" for the particular publisher

if YES to all => I can publish Open Access without any additional payments!

Warning: in publishers' systems there are usually not the actual official names of institutions (and there are more variants as well)

Lessons learned

NATK 50°6'14.083"N, 14°23'26.365"E Národní technická knihovna National Library of Technology

- Having a dedicated OA administrator is highly desirable at least for large institutions (universities)
- OA uptake could be inhibited by:
 - authors not aware of the options and afraid of payments
 - suboptimal workflow on publisher's side (problematic wording of notices, wrong timing, ...)
- Publishers' systems are still in rapid developments and are changing frequently
- Significant amount of "tokens/APCs" for major publishers was the key moment when institutions and researchers finally understood what this means
