- Output: All <u>our material</u> is open
- Quality: Measured by feedback (<u>example</u>)
- **Reach**: We reach <u>500-1000 learners</u> each year
- Community: Total number of messages in our open chat: 92844
- **Nordic-RSE**: Yearly un-conference. First in-person conference in 2024.
- International connections: We get invited to conference workshops and BoFs, and asked for endorsements
- GitLab: Over 288 active users, 226 groups, with over 390 active projects
