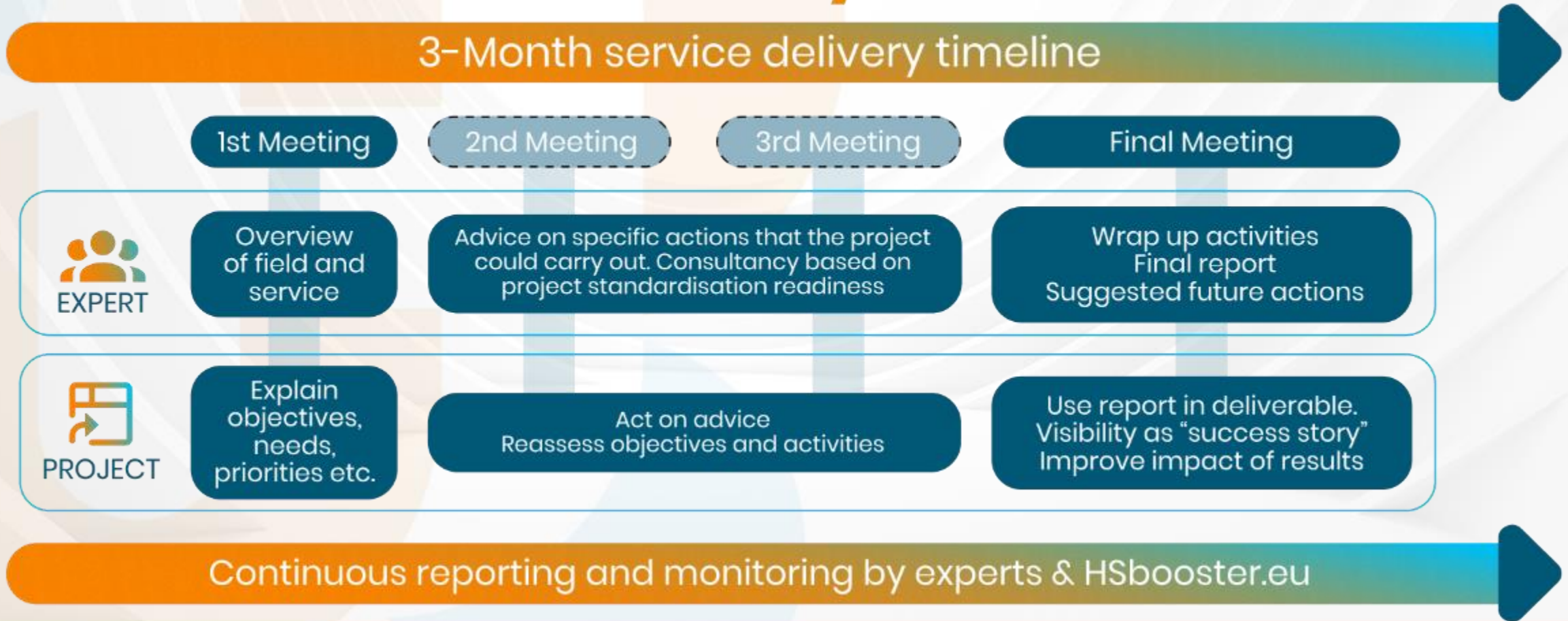

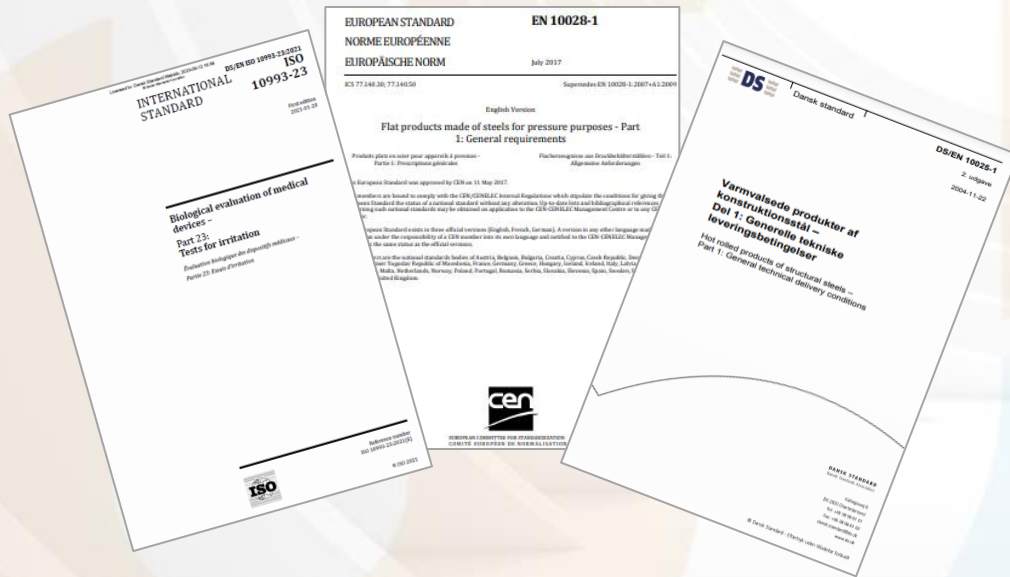

# CEN Workshop Agreement

- Pre-normative document for that can be used as a reference document to
  - facilitate interoperability and compatibility,
  - enhance market uptake
  - create trust in innovative solutions
- Steppingstone towards standardization
- Secretariat by a national standard body is required

After only 6-12 months, an agreement called a 'CWA' can be put in place, which serves as the basis for new standards—based on your research. A CWA is published globally and takes 4 simple steps to create:

## Proposal for workshop

Anyone can propose and join the workshop.



## Drafting phase

Development of a draft document in a collaborative environment

## Voluntary commenting

Anyone can comment on a draft CWA.



## Publication

Standards such as CWAs are available worldwide.

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# HSbooster.eu Training Academy

## target audience what we learned, evolved and adapt

### **Specific but not homogenous target audience:** Researchers

#### **Target group** **general** **characteristics**

- impartial
- analytic view
- critical thinking (so what?)
- transmission of their research results (message) through research papers (IF, H index, I index)
- focus on research
- they learn from research

#### **How to train researchers?**

The content analysis of interviews with 21 researchers (random sample) suggests:

- They need a **broader understanding** of standardisation (influence on affective factors – attitudes, motivation or values)
- **Motivation** might be a problem. How can that help me? What for?
- Used to **the academic style** of communication.
- **Lack of time** for advancing in something other than their core research area
- Interested in **expanding their networks** (for future project submissions)

*Based on an analysis of 32 projects' potential training needs:*

- Some projects have a *particular standardisation strategy*
- some projects have a *vague picture of what they want*
- Variety of sectors*

*Analysis of 54 experts' needs for training support:*

- Some experts have *remarkable experience, and some are less experienced*
- Variety of sectors*

**Challenge: Researchers in PC** - wide variety of group dynamics & different types of PC – how to make closer standardisation to all of them

**Based on my experience with the STRATEGY R&I Project, my advice to research projects in terms of how to learn on standardization: First of all I would like to share the aspects/factors that I consider as BEST PRACTICES / choices and which implemented by the STRATEGY Project (1):**

- ✓ A Trusted, powerful, efficient consortium scheme and partners group should be established from the very beginning of the Project
- ✓ A very well Project Management structure should be from the very beginning; Satways Ltd was an outstandingly experienced Project Coordinator and its Team of Project Managers who assigned very concrete tasks and areas of responsibility, was a best practice that ensured results and communication of clear messages. Continuity and accountability were parts of the communication practice.
- ✓ A very concrete identification of standards gaps and needs was implemented from the very beginning of the Project and was followed-up by the liaison officer till the end of the project
- ✓ 5 NSBs joined and undertook specific roles per thematic Stream and as Workshop's Secretariats during the realisation of each CWA.

# ***Boosting standardisation in R&I projects - Achievements, experiences and the road ahead***

**Based on my experience with the STRATEGY R&I Project, my advice to research projects in terms of how to learn on standardization:**

**First of all I would like to share the aspects/factors that I consider as BEST PRACTICES / choices and which implemented by the STRATEGY Project (2):**

- ❖ Table Top Exercises and Full Scale Exercises validated the content, the progress and the results of each CWA and their interoperability too.
- ❖ Vivid Liaison activities established with relevant ISO and CEN TCs (In February 2022, ISO approved STRATEGY 's candidacy for a Liaison Category C in the ISO/TC 292: Security and Resilience and Working Group (WG) 3: Emergency Management, while the liaison with CEN/TC 391 approved in November 2021). Start date 1/9/2020, End date 31/8/2023 (6/10/2023). If we had joined earlier, we might started SOONER the relevant activities and interaction.

# ***Boosting standardisation in R&I projects - Achievements, experiences and the road ahead***

**SECONDLY, in general, based on my experience with the STRATEGY R&I Project, my advice to research projects in terms of how to learn on standardization (3) :**

- ❖ To proactively be informed and follow up on the Standardisation policies, initiatives, and bodies related to the topic(s) of their project (all websites are accessible, transparent processes)
- ❖ To proactively attend, and participate in relevant events (remotely and physically)
- ❖ To be in contact and establish strategical interactions with key-actors and stakeholders
- ❖ To attend HSBooster Training Academy's courses and be active members of its community by taking advantage of the HSBooster tools, platform, material, network
- ❖ To be trained, to be aware of the Code of Practice on Standardisation.

# ***Boosting standardisation in R&I projects - Achievements, experiences and the road ahead***

**SECONDLY, in general, based on my experience with the STRATEGY R&I Project, my advice to research projects in terms of how to learn on standardization (4) :**

- ❖ To establish from the very beginning internal brainstorming meetings on the standardization topics
- ❖ To involve NSBs as consortium partners and TCs Conveners / Chairpersons as ABMs and/or partners
- ❖ To be registered and actively participate and contribute in CEN CENELEC ETSI TCs. When we engage in CEN-CENELEC standardization activities, this can be done through direct participation in national mirror committees or by linking our specific projects to European standardization activities. Take a look in the CEN CENLEC Guide 23 (*“Research Consortium Bridge Addressing Research and Innovation in European Standardization activities and deliverables”*, Edition 3, October 2020).

# ***Boosting standardisation in R&I projects - Achievements, experiences and the road ahead***



## **My Advice for the HSBooster.eu Training academy on how to better serve the target audience/researchers (1):**

- ❖ To constantly provide its successful training courses as does
- ❖ To organize more field-focused and customized training courses addressed to consortia, projects, researchers, key-stakeholders including standardisers (Many times, Tight deadlines do not offer the luxury of empathy; each part has its own priorities and agendas and thus it is essential to learn to **Put ourselves in Other People's Shoes**). Such training courses could be provided in the form of serious games, TTxs, and or living labs (similar to the [Living Labs as Regulatory Learning Tools](#)), for a more interactive and engaging way of learning).
- ❖ Thus, To extend and invest in training courses addressed to TCs leadership, chairpersons, conveners, and members (the aim here is to gain the leadership (facilitation, communication) capacities of eliciting/harnessing/ the best possible of the researches and the R&I projects' outcomes).

## My Advice for the HSBooster.eu Training academy on how to better serve the target audience/researchers (2) :

- ❖ To extend and invest more in ICT standardization thematic topics (we live to an increasingly smart, interconnected and interdependent world, therefore the provision of training in topics related to standards and standardization on AI, ML, Quantum Computing, IoT, Edge and Cloud Computing, would be very useful and urgently required very soon. Such a planning could be in alignment with Bplans and WPS of TCs, and the AUWPS
- ❖ Similarly, the HSBooster Academy could extend its services, on supporting consortia in co-drafting the standardization sections of their proposals and following up on the progress till the end of the projects, i.e. in
