
## Top 4 priority areas for emerging DLT and blockchain standards

1. Identity Management

2. Data Provenance

3. Governance

4. Tokenisation, digital asset creation and exchange



**Blockchain core capabilities**

- Identity management**  
e.g., self-sovereignty; privacy; anonymity; account abstraction; secure wallet management
- Data provenance**  
e.g., on/off-chain data flows; data trustworthiness; verifiable oracle services/registries
- Governance**  
e.g., stakeholder reputation including roles, rights and responsibilities across the on/off-chain process; online voting; DAOs; peer-to-peer virtual communities
- Token / asset creation and exchange**  
e.g., cryptocurrency; virtual assets; fungible and non-fungible tokens; exchange protocols
- Process optimisation**  
e.g., process transparency; multi-party, interoperable, cloud-based resource-sharing; 5G and mobile edge computing; energy efficiency
- Automation**  
e.g., smart contracts; intelligent agency; robotics
- Cybersecurity**  
e.g., open source, distributed and decentralised system architectures; end-point security; encryption; consensus mechanisms



## **SEEBLOCKS public consultation**

### **Top 5 gaps that if addressed would enable wider adoption of DLT**

1. The potential of blockchain and DLT in business and society is poorly understood.
2. Increase education, open standards and interoperability
3. Consideration of the sustainable economy is vital
4. Strong cyber protections, information security and governance are key
5. Strong legal grounding is vital for widespread and accelerated adoption.


