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Closed science

Why are some science-related materials/data/code not shared?

- Risk of being scooped
- Fear of blaming oneself (imposter syndrome)
- Lack of awareness (who is allowed to publish my work?)
- Assumption: it's not worth the effort.







Open Science

Open Training

- Research related (hot topics)
 - Often tailored towards general audience (science communication)
- Earliest at the time a manuscript is published (e.g. as preprint)




- Routine tasks (colder topics)
- Transfer of domain-specific knowledge






Am I allowed to publish my stuff?

Define responsibilities and procedures early!



Where to share?

- Open *training* related content
 - bioRxiv (manuscripts, no reviews)
 - Figshare
 - <u>F1000</u>
 - Bioimage Archive (data)
 - <u>Github</u> (code)
 - <u>Zenodo</u>
 - Focalplane
 - Institutional servers (if there is no alternative)


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Indexing

- Do not trust google to make your stuff findable 🔇 NFDI4BioImage Training Materia 🗙 🕂

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

A repository of online microscopy resources

The goal of MicroscopyDB is to make it easier for everyone to find online information related to microscopy MicroscopyDB does not store the microscopy-related content itself. Instead, it contains links to existing online microscopy resources (educational materials, jobs etc.). It has several advantages

- sharing a job, event or other online resource only requires one submission to MicroscopyDB and then it appears on multiple partner community websites
- it channels visitors to partner website for the searchable content
- · it avoids duplication and helps visitors find relevant information a one-stop shop for all levels of microscopy use

- Restrictive
 - You can reuse our stuff, but only if you ...
 - License your work with the same license we do
 - Make your stuff openly available
 - Make no money with derivatives of our work
 - Examples: GPL, CC-BY-SA, CC-BY-NC, CC-BY-ND
- Permissive licensing:
 - Do whatever you like with our stuff, just make sure to mention / cite us ...
 - Examples: BSD, MIT, Apache, CC-BY

I conclude, these are less *open* in a sense






