Why do we need standardisation?

Standards are definitions which give us:

- Consistency in measuring and evaluating product performance.
- Markets with seamless integration of products from different companies.
- Consumer guarantees that products are safe, durable, and fairly priced.

Without standards, we compromise the robustness of industries, economic growth, and our capacity to achieve key strategic initiatives like the European Green Deal. However, limited and fragmented educational resources prevent standardisation uptake. This is where the EDU4Standards research project will innovate standardisation education in European Higher Education Institutes, with 5 key strategic objectives to ensure that standardisation is embedded into the European educational framework.
