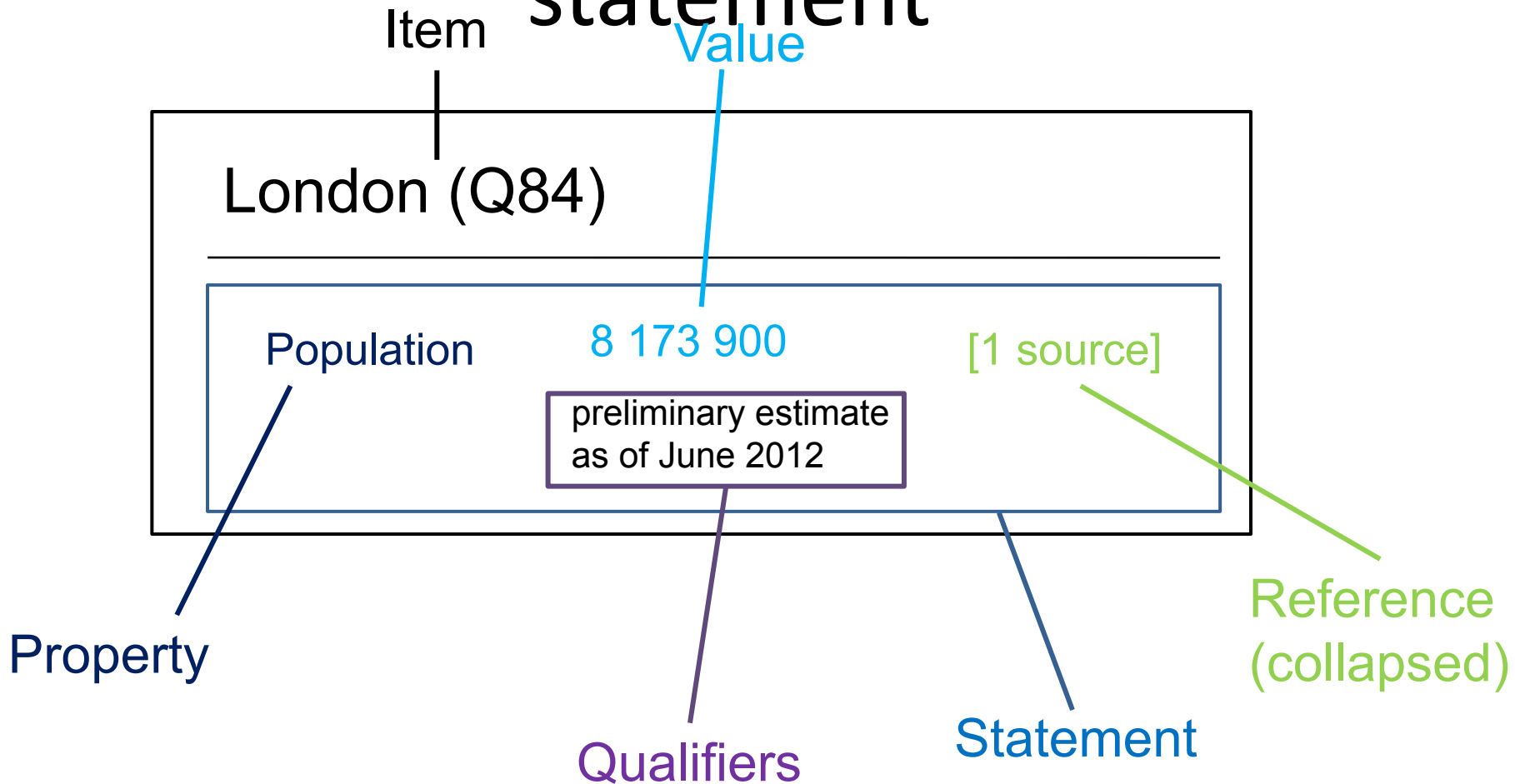

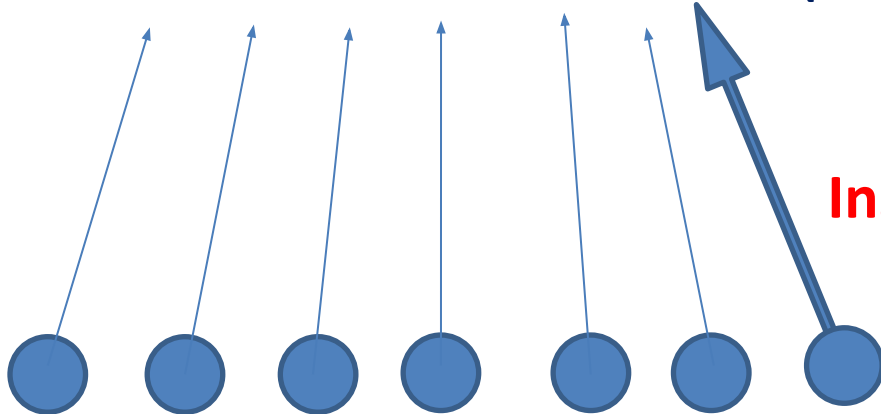

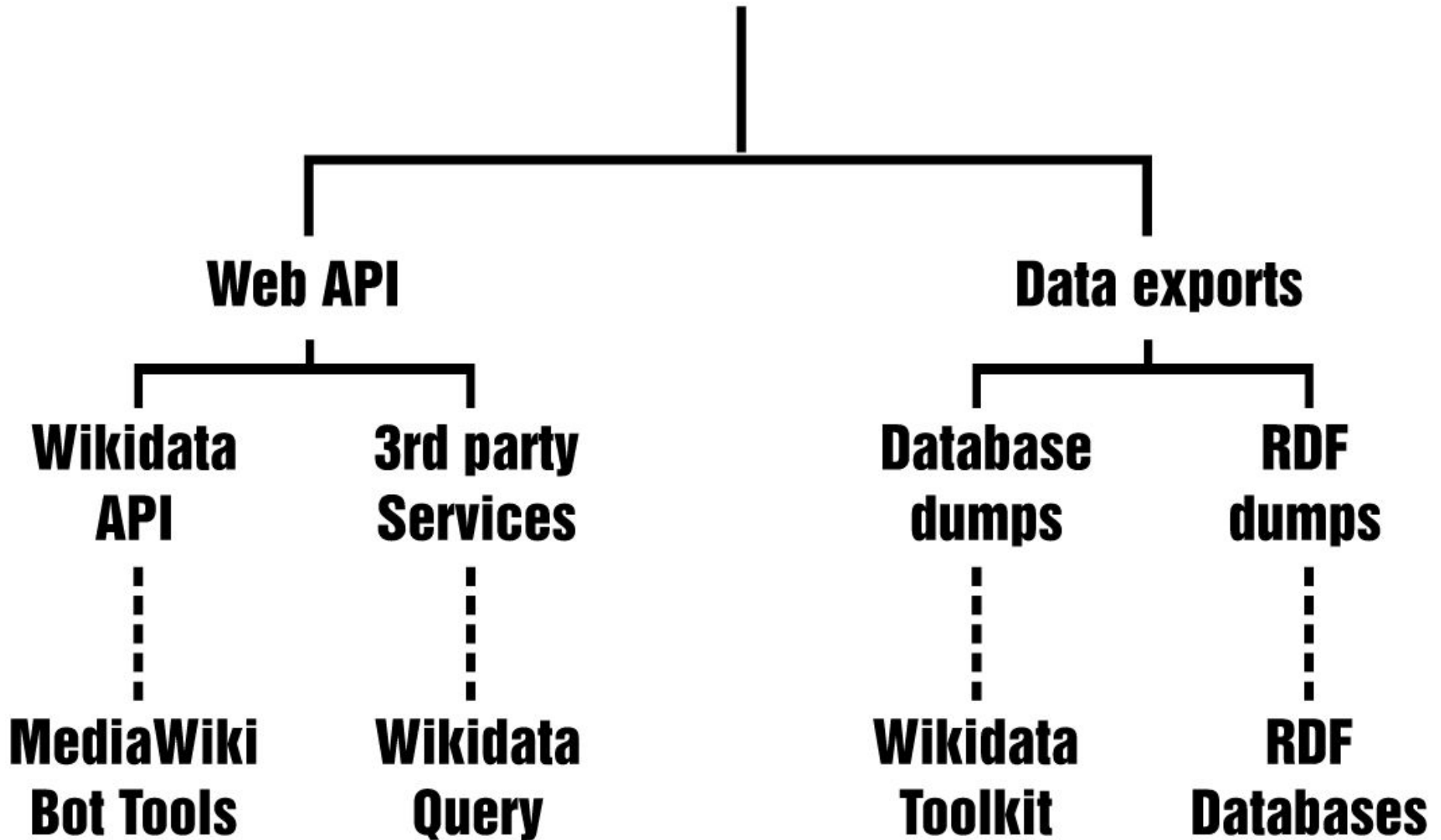

- **225 million edits** (since project launch in 2012)

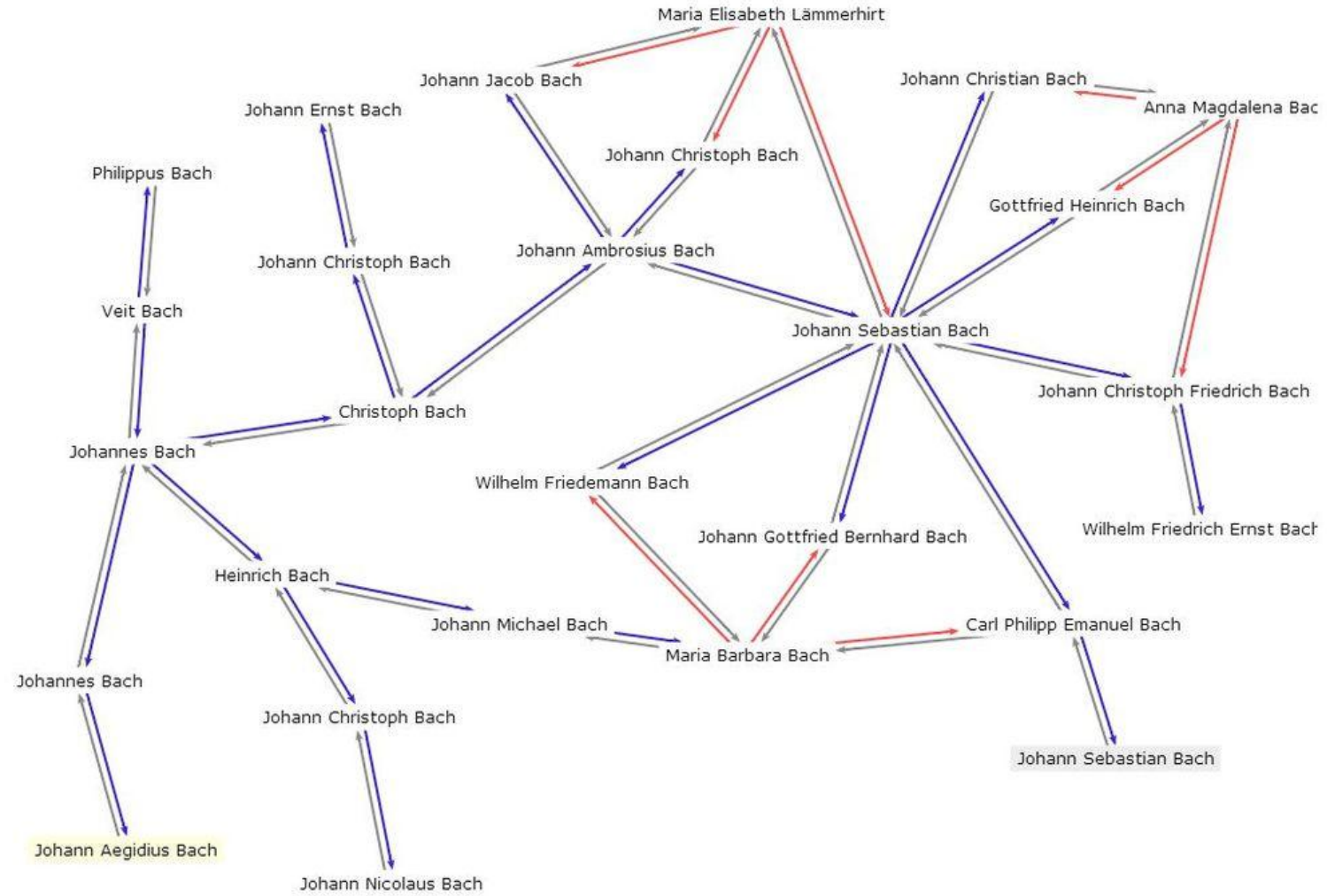

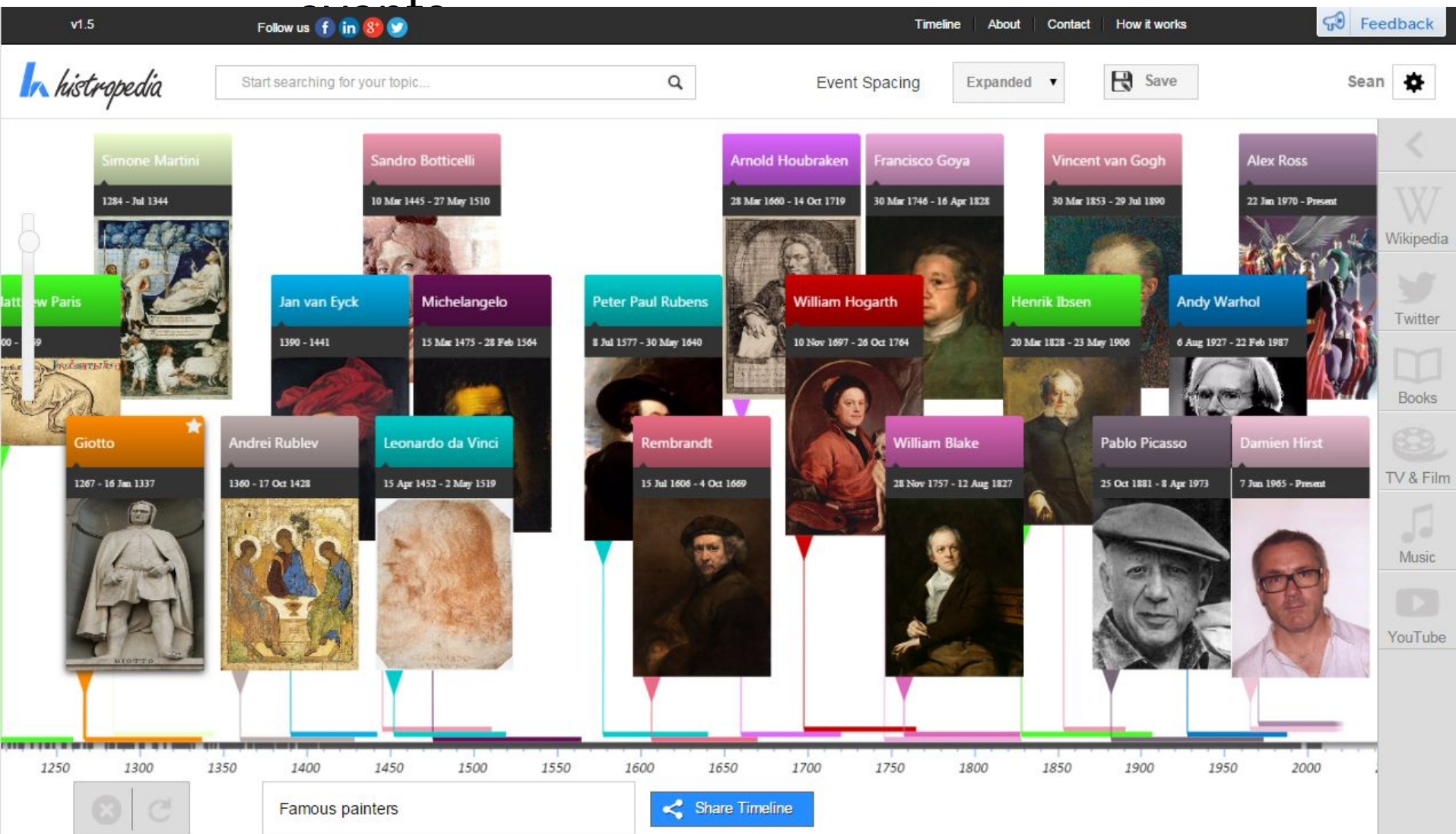

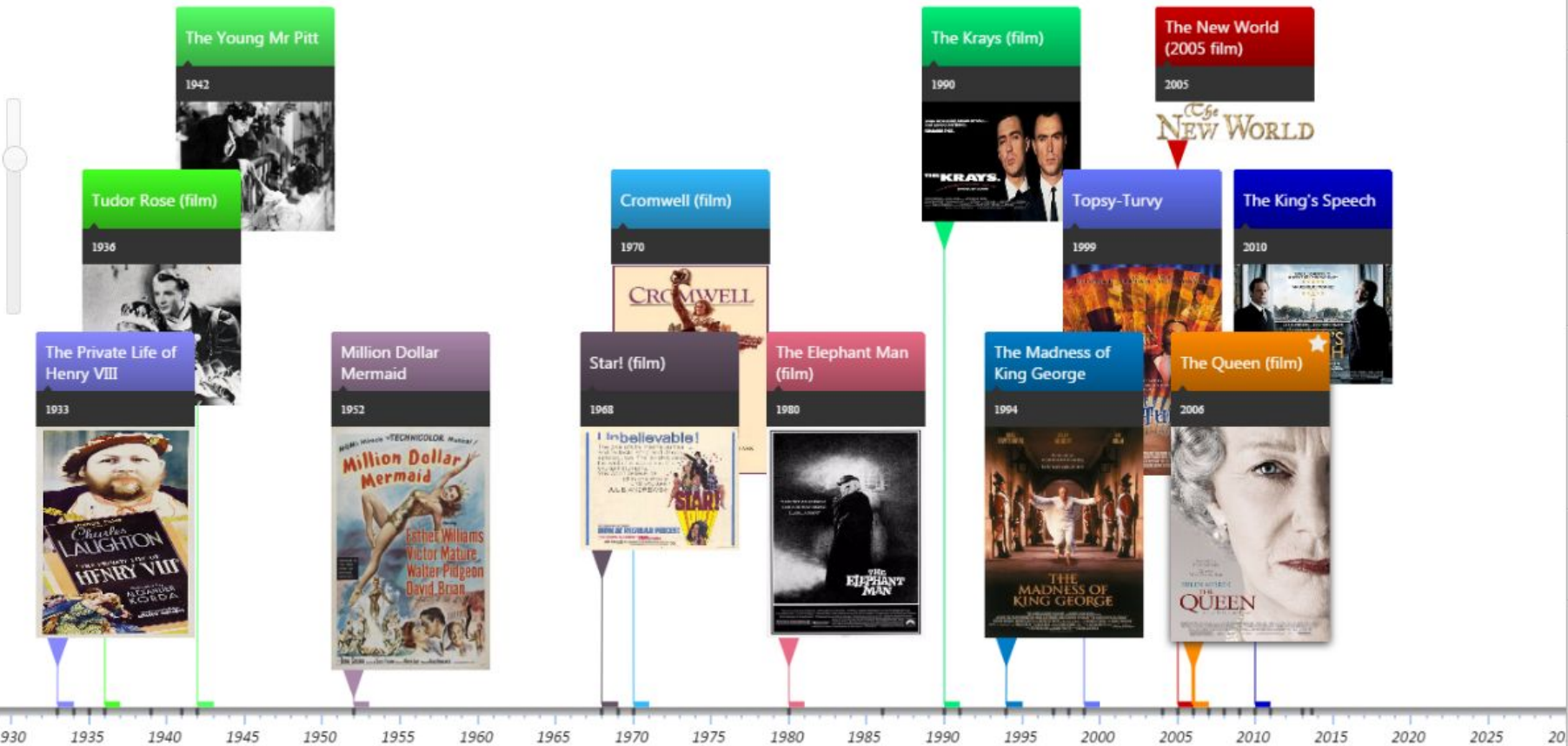
