LIWHAP- The Low-income Household Water Assistance program is a limited term, federally application that gives financial help the eligible low income Californias to help control their residential water utility costs.

LIWP-The low-income weatherization programs offers low-income households with photo voltaic systems and energy effectively upgrades as no costs.
