

Who is RDA – Professional Title









RDA Secretary General visit to Latin America and the Carribean

 - Chile: May 23 and 24












Evaluation of Research in the RDA

- The RDA is an appropriate forum to discuss the evolution of evaluation of research as they relate to Open Science practices
 - Global reach
 - Diversity of community profiles
 - Funders' Forum and Organisational Members
- Interest Group (IG) created in June 2023 to organise the discussion on the subject, in particular as it relates to data, and also in relation to RDA activities on research software





RDA Role in the Evaluation of Research Landscape

- First IG output
 - <u>Draft</u> will be discussed during the RDA P22 IG sessions (14-23 May 2024)
- Diversity of RDA topics => Diversity of possible contributions
- Five categories
 - Possible metrics and criteria
 - Stakeholder representation
 - Research outputs and their relevant properties
 - Disciplinary aspects
 - Support activities contributing to the ecosystem progression


Two examples of relevant RDA Outputs

RDA Data Usage Metrics WG Recommendations

- The document outlines next steps and recommendations for widespread adoption of normalized data usage practices, as well as hurdles and limitations to be prioritized going forward. Repositories that utilize these recommendations will help drive a better understanding of data usage and contribute towards the development of research data assessment metrics.

- Sharing Rewards and Credits (SHARC) IG

- Initial task: mapping RDA activities and outputs with CoARA WGs












