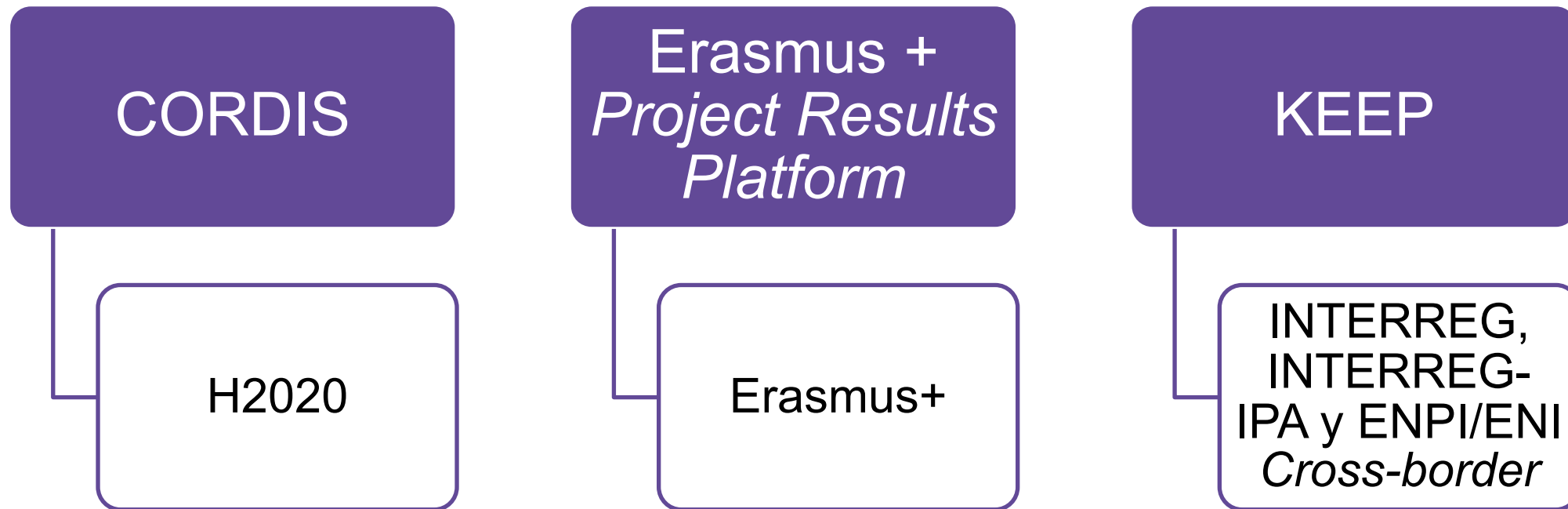

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Is the project carried out in different countries?

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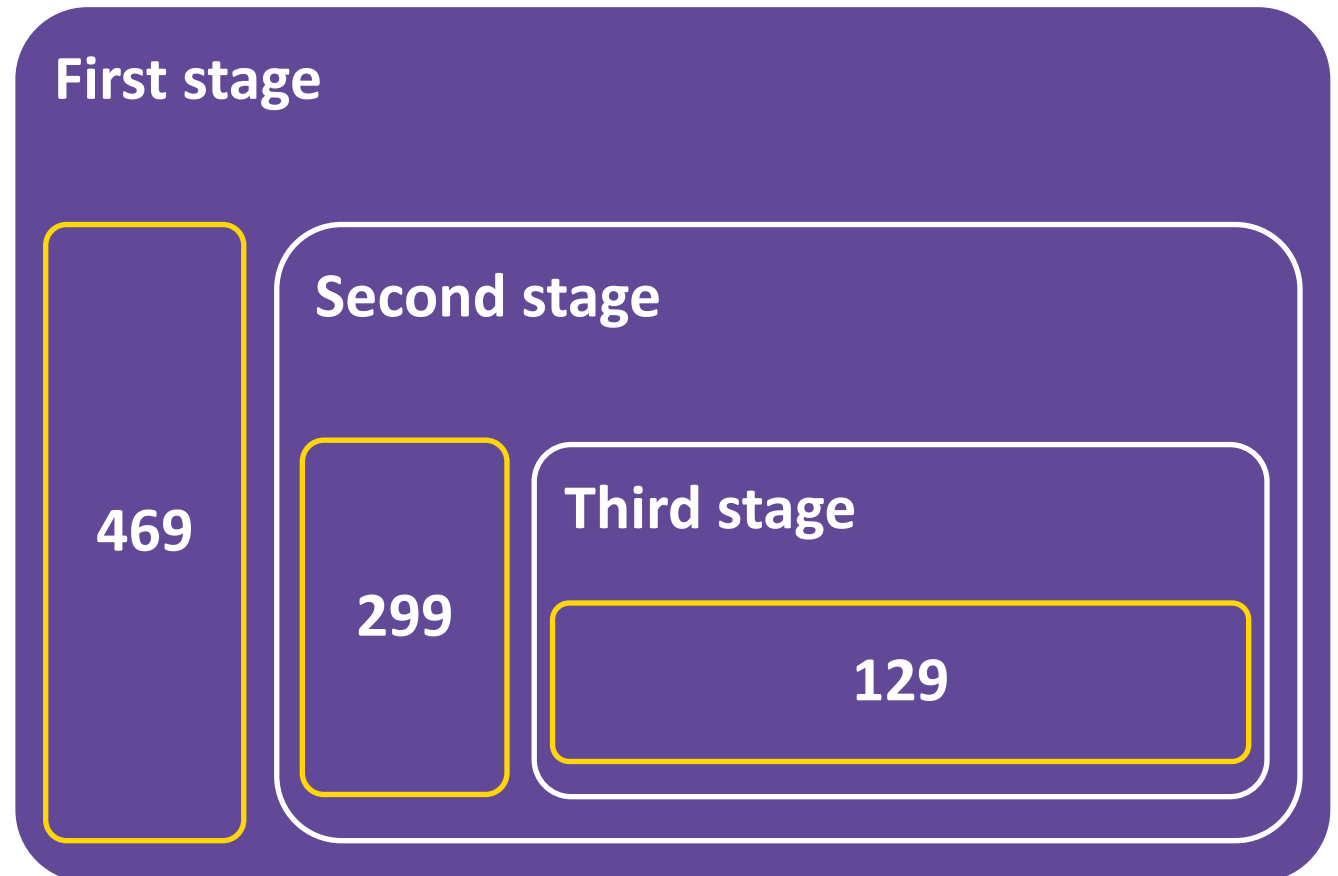
Does the project carry out any evaluation process focused on diversity?
