#### Dear BrightSpace Community,

April has been an exciting month for us, marking the conclusion of our first reporting period. Since the project's inception in November 2022, we've made significant strides, culminating in the submission of our first batch of 11 reports to the EU commission. Having been deeply involved in the preparation of several of these reports, I have witnessed firsthand the remarkable commitment and dedication of our partners. I want to extend my sincerest gratitude to everyone for their hard work and contributions to this achievement!

Throughout this first reporting period, we've completed crucial milestones and launched numerous collaborative efforts. Notable activities included the kick-offs of various work packages, and the initiation of project data acquisition, often in collaboration with our fellow Horizon Europe project, LAMASUS. A significant highlight was the joint development of baseline data with LAMASUS, which has provided a robust foundation for our future activities.

The early part of 2023 saw the beginning of productive collaborations with other Horizon Europe fellow projects, such as GeneBEcon and RATION. These partnerships bore fruit quickly, as evidenced by our presence at the EAAE congress in Rennes in September 2023. There, we hosted two pre-conference sessions: one with GeneBEcon and RATION on novel plant protection products, and another with LAMASUS on baseline construction.

October 2023 was a particularly eventful month. We presented BrightSpace at a DG AGRI workshop in Brussels, showcasing our progress and ambitions to a wider audience. This was followed by our first annual meeting in Prague, generously hosted by the Czech University of Life Sciences (CZU). A key outcome of this meeting was the introduction of the first version of the Safe and Just Operating Space (SJOS) indicator framework, which we later presented to stakeholders during our first Thematic Seminar at the end of October.

Our visibility and integration with other initiatives continued into early 2024. BrightSpace was featured at the LAMASUS annual meeting and the at the kick-off meeting of our new fellow Horizon Europe project ACT4CAP27. To prepare for the first round of project deliverables, we organized an all-partner modelling seminar in March 2024, focusing on developing model indicators within the SJOS framework.

April 2024 was highlighted by our second Thematic Seminar on biodiversity indicators and the intensive work on our project reports. We also received invaluable support from the Scientific and Policy Advisory Board, who provided crucial reviews and insights to ensure the ongoing relevance and impact of our work. Several papers based on these deliverables are now in the pipeline for publication.

Looking ahead, we have some exciting events on the horizon. Our first Stakeholder Retreat is scheduled for June 2024, followed by our first project review meeting in July. Post-summer, we'll be preparing for our second annual meeting, which will be held back-to-back with LAMASUS and generously hosted by the Joint Research Centre (JRC) in Seville, Spain.

As we look forward to the coming months, we remain committed to advancing the objectives of BrightSpace and fostering meaningful collaborations.




