2. Koege Bight, Denmark – Recording of video sequences to provide insights regarding site seabed.
3. Porsangerfjorden, Norway – Prior to reef deployment, a series of bottle sampling was performed to characterize the substrate.
4. Tarragona, Spain – Analysis of bathymetry data, environmental conditions and the characteristics of protected areas, habitats and substrate.
