What is HSbooster.eu?

- **European project:** HSbooster.eu is launched by the EU Commission
 - Pilot project: April 2022 September 2024
 - Consortium: Danish Standards (DK), Trust-IT (IT), University of Belgrade (RS), Dublin City University (IE), and SGS (ES)

Free of charge Booster Service

- Support-tools for EU-projects
- Various support levels Training academy, workshops, webinars, one-to-one consultancy with experts
- **Target groups:** Horizon 2020 and Horizon Europe projects and standardisation experts



What is the aim of HSbooster.eu?

- Increased participation of researchers in standardization activities
- Increased development of new standards or revision of existing standards
- Create a stronger link between R&I and standardization incorporate standardization early in research
- Increased dissemination of new technologies using input from research projects for the development of standards
- Respond to new industrial and market conditions

HSbooster.eu for standardisation experts

- Experts give guidance to the EU projects, that have applied for the open calls
 - e.g., access to and usage of standards, standardization processes, access to TCs, harmonization, legislation, Sreqs ...
- Access to standardization resources and material to give advice on
- Individually matched to a project that fits their area of expertise
- One complete service by experts:
 - 2-4 online meetings (ca. 1 hour duration per meeting over a maximum of 4 months)
 - Work corresponds to 2 full working days per complete service delivery
 - Experts receive 800 EUR per completed service
