

1. Deliverable Summary

This deliverable presents the deployment status of the demonstrators for the seven (7) pilots that will be implemented during the project, targeting specific communities. It should be clarified that the different demonstrators evolve at different time periods of the project. This means that some of them are currently more mature, whereas other demonstrators will evolve at a later stage following the milestones that have been set in the project DoA. For this reason, this deliverable is of type "other" and working URLs of the demonstrators along with their timeline for deployment are provided at the project wiki, which will be updated during the project lifetime.

Another important point is that these demonstrators will benefit from the following modules of the CAPSELLA platform, which are briefly presented below and they are fully documented at the project wiki:

• The Data Management System: Offers data storage, retrieval and query facilities on top of the available datasets




Figure 1: Interaction of CAPSELLA Demonstrators with CAPSELLA Platform Services
