Hail! From **Mānagr̥ha**, a great devotee of gods, **mahārāja Vasantadeva** meditating upon the feet of divine father **mahārāja Śrīpāda** with clear fame blossomed through knowledge of holy men, discipline, mercy, gift making, cleverness, virtues and glory, enjoying all health, issues this decree to the four offices and others...after duly enquiring of the health of all the families and the chiefs of the village of...

Please know this...I...**Liṅgvala**...**Kūthera**...to the office...**Bhaṭṭāraka**...theirs...in the tasks...I also...theirs...have freed...whoever of my servants getting livelihood at my feet transcends this order and does otherwise we shall take severe actions against them. This is our order (**samājnāpanā**) The date: **Samvat 435 Āsvayuja śukla divā 1** and the witness is the Chief Minister and Grand Usherer **Ravigupta**. The **Brahmuṇi Mahīśila** is administering the area.
