Route 1: via support programmes providing guidance and one-toone support:

The new open call under this route opened in June 2024:

- Targeting National Level Initiatives
- Webinar to introduce support programme 8 May 2024 (recording available)
- Virtual clinics 18 and 20 June 2024 to answer questions from potential applicants
- Deadline for applications: 12 July 2024
- Notifications to applicants: end of July / early August 2024
- Start of support action: later September 2024

Route 2: via cascading grants to enable testing of specific tools, approaches and methods

The call is currently closed, the support programme is ongoing The final Route 2 open call opens on **30 September 2024.**







FAIR Implementation Catalogue






