



Red Yam




This is Mary, this is Liseng. The two are friends.


This is Rose and this is Yokon. The two are friends with Mary and Liseng.




Everyone is busy working in the garden.






They rest a little and then Yokon goes to the bush [to pee].


Then, Rose also goes into the bush.


After a while, Mary and Liseng go back to the garden.


When they come back, they see that a red yam that Mary has planted is gone.


Mary asks Liseng: "Who has eaten my red yam?"


Liseng says: "It might have been Yokon, or it might have been Rose."




But Mary says: "No, it can't have been Rose. It must have been Yokon who ate my red yam"






"If her teeth are red, then Yokon has eaten your red yam."


So Mary goes to Yokon and is mad at her.




Mary says: "Yokon, you ate my red yam!"


