




Research Contracts Benchmarking A high-level comparison between Australia and the UK




Workload

Australian institutions have a higher workload per individual, but figures per institution vary widely across the two countries, from 45 to 430 contracts per full time equivalent research contracts team member (FTE).

Change in contract volumes

Between 2015 and 2017, Australian participants have seen a higher increase in average contracts per institution. Some UK institutions reported a decrease in contract volumes.






Average cost per contract

Even though Australian participants reported a higher number of contracts per FTE, the average cost per contract is lower in the UK.

Average salary cost per FTE


At £67,230/AU\$118,120, the average salary cost per FTE, including on-costs, reported by Australian participants is over 40% higher than in the UK. Part of this difference is explained by the higher cost of living and salary levels in Australia.





Use of software

73% of Australian participants stated that they use contracttracking software, while only 37% of UK institutions reported the same. In the UK, Excel spreadsheets are more commonly used.
