What is an Academic Standard Day?

- Academic Standard Days are stand-alone interest creating events at higher education institutes across Europe targeting students in the domains of engineering and business among others
- The aim is to strengthen the link between standardization and R&I as well as address the need to form the next generation of standard drafters
- The events will also act as dissemination opportunities for EDU4Standards.









What is the scope of the Academic Standard Days?

- 15 Academic Standard Days in 10 different European countries
- With the participation of at least...
 - 1 NSB
 - 1 University/HEI
 - 100 students
 - 10 teachers
 - 5 industry representatives
 - ..In each ASD
- Form the base for the creation of a European
 Student Standardisation Association






What is the status?



- The challenges as they are perceived so far by HEI project partners:
 - Providing incentive for the students to participate
 - Identifying the best communication channels for the event
 - The topic is unknown to students
 - Engaging teachers/academic professionals
 who are not directly involved in the project
 - It takes time to build up interest and awareness for a new topic
 - Perception of standardisation as boring and/or barrier to innovation





How will the ASDs be organised?

- The **Academic Standard Days** will be organised in two phases:
 - First phase: test concepts and gather experience in MOCK ASDs organised with the direct participation of project partners (5 ASDs)
 - Second phase: open call for interest to NSBs to host ASDs selection based on meeting criteria and best value for money, not necessary to involve project partners directly in the organisation (10 ASDs)
- The project will cover the cost to host the ASD up to EUR 12.000
