






What did we want to do ?



- An exploratory and comparative investigation on libraries assessment and evaluation indicators in Europe
- Know how academic libraries in Europe face research evolutions, teaching/learning new models and the strongly growing number of students
- The question was : what would we find ? Which data would be available ? Which indicators could be built ? Would they be comparable ?



How did we do ?




= 26 common data

What did we achieve ?


- A benchmark covering 4 years and 13 countries, assessing :
 - Libraries buildings and equipment, space and seats per student, opening days and hours, frequentation rate, library services, users training, staff per student / documentary budgets / total expenditure, staff training, documentation loans / consultation / downloads, in both relative and absolute value.




What shall we do now ?

4. Improve the way of collect to make sure the data are coherent and comparable
5. Think about how to enrich the data and the indicators to better assess the contribution of libraries in student success or research performance
