 - 33 partners plus 16 third parties

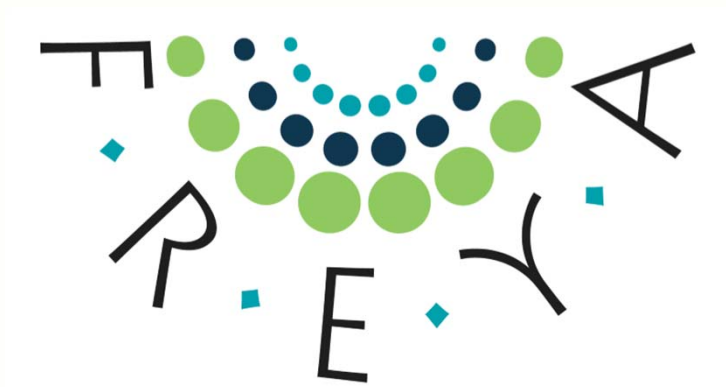

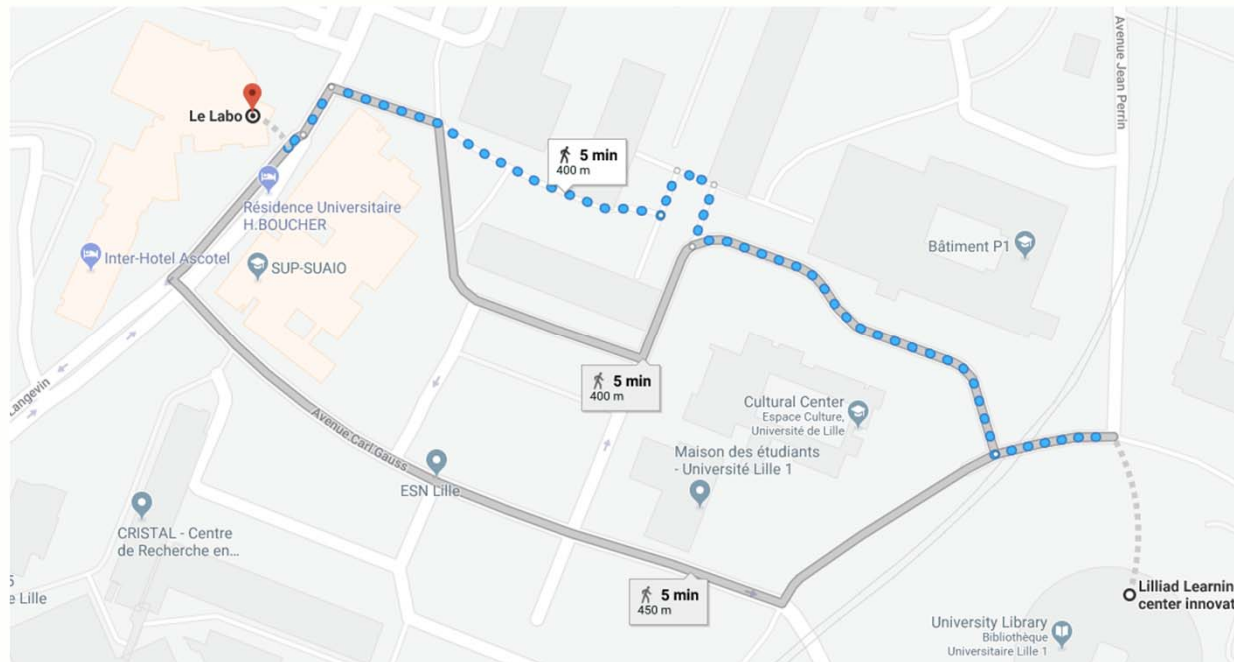
