




## WHO? National Platform Open science: commitment from decision makers / boards of science organisations!

### Theme's:

- 1. 100% open access publications
- 2. Making **research data** optimally fit for reuse
- 3. Recognition of and **rewards** for researchers (scientific and social impact of research output)
- 4. Promoting and supporting open science









## **Reward system OS > leading for ZonMw:**

The Ensuring Value in Research (EViR) Funders' Collaboration and Development Forum

- to advance the practices of health related research and research funding,
  - guiding principles 'reducing waste, and increasing value of research'




#### Recommendations National Platform Open Science

- Funding requirements and Reviewing grant proposals:
  - track record of the scientist / applicant: OAP, FAIR data,
     sharing data, involve societal stakeholders
  - Train review committees to do so
