01. What does 'mainzed' mean?

mainzed - overview

mainzed is an acronym for 'Mainz Centre for Digitality in the Humanities and Cultural Studies' and at the same time alludes to the English word mindset.

02. Is mainzed an institute?

mainzed was founded as a joint initiative in 2015 and does not have a partictular legal form. It has neither been established as an institution nor as an association in order to avoid the development of a new bureaucratic superstructure. Hence, the focus of mainzed is entirely put upon the themed cooperation of structures that are already existing.

03. Who works at mainzed?

Formally, mainzed is merely composed of the managing director. The other members such as the director work for one of the six partners of mainzed.


04. Who founded mainzed?



mainzed is no service centre but it is trying to assist researchers with the identification and choice of digital tools and methods. Often, mainzed is able to help by contacting experts from all over Germany via its network. Important note: the earlier you talk to us about your project, the more effective our measures are.

09. Is mainzed offering courses?

10. Are there any charges at mainzed?

mainzed is not a service provider and hence does not charge fees for its services. We render support out of the conviction that large-scale digital research is only possible by cooperating with various scientific institutions in Mainz.

As a network, mainzed does not host any hardware or technical infrastructure. Computer centres and further offices of the partners are responsible for these requirements. However, mainzed can help with identifying the requirements for a project.

Important aspects are merely competences, experiences and motivation.

15. Can I study at mainzed?

It is not possible to study directly at mainzed but the contents of the master's degree programme Digital Methods in the Humanities and Cultural Studies are supported by mainzed. The degree programme is closely linked to research practice and thus provides very good opportunities for graduates in the labour market.

16. Which degree do I need for the master's degree programme?

Applicants who have a bachelor's degree in the humanities, cultural studies or with a focus in computer science can be admitted to the full-time study programme comprising four semesters.

17. Where do I apply for the degree programme?

You can apply for the master's degree programme at the University of Mainz. Yet, you will be enrolled at the University of Mainz as well as at the Mainz University of Applied Sciences.

18. Can I do an internship at mainzed?

mainzed is offering many opportunities for internships: On the one hand, you can do an internship directly at one of the partner institutions within the network and work with digital edition, music informatics or 3D scans. On the other hand, it is possible to work at the managing office in order to get an insight into scientific management.

19. Are there student jobs available at mainzed?

mainzed has regular demand for students who want to work at the managing office or at the partner institutions. Here, we are looking for research assistants depending on the task field, e.g. for programming work, for the organisation of events, for editorial work etc.
