## Aims and Objectives

The TWG identifies services and tools for research collections and provenance research. The aim is to create an international online catalogue that reflects domain-specific needs (KPI 2.2). This will provide a status quo of the current digital tools in provenance research. A particular focus will be placed on the object-specific management of (name) standard data, i.e. data on previous owners and sellers, which on the one hand are persons and on the other hand are corporate bodies. Characteristics of archaeological and ethnological objects and their inherent legal components will be specifically taken into account.

## Out of Scope

Only digital publications are included. Digitized versions of print publications and digital publications in traditional formats (books, journals, articles, encyclopedias and theses) are not

included. Also excluded are blogs, social media accounts, excavation, exhibition and project websites without formally structured datasets, general public websites and media, and collections of web links. Databases and datasets that are supplementary to traditional books and articles are also not included.

### Intended Work Results

Inventory of vocabularies, databases, digitized archive materials, digitized print materials, image datasets, spreadsheets, text datasets, websites relevant to provenance research.
