Conclusion

While there are many promising developments in (meta)data provision that facilitate more diverse, fair and relevant research evaluations, there are also qualities with lacking or limited availability. The need for new code that can match (meta)data supply with indicator demands to support customized evaluations is presented as both a challenge and opportunity for the scientometric and research intelligence communities.
