


Embracing the Gray of Digital Preservation

The Gray Repo is a "dim digital preservation archive" that provides limited curatorial access, akin to a physical archival storage facility, where items are stored on shelves in an environmentally regulated and well managed manner, and appropriately described in conformance with accepted standards, while the public and unvetted personnel are not allowed to wander the stacks.





Gaps Addressed:

Provides formalized path to preservation for:

- born digital content
- temporally restricted digital content
- digitized preservation files for content that resides in other University Libraries repositories, such as the Knowledge Bank and Internet Archive
