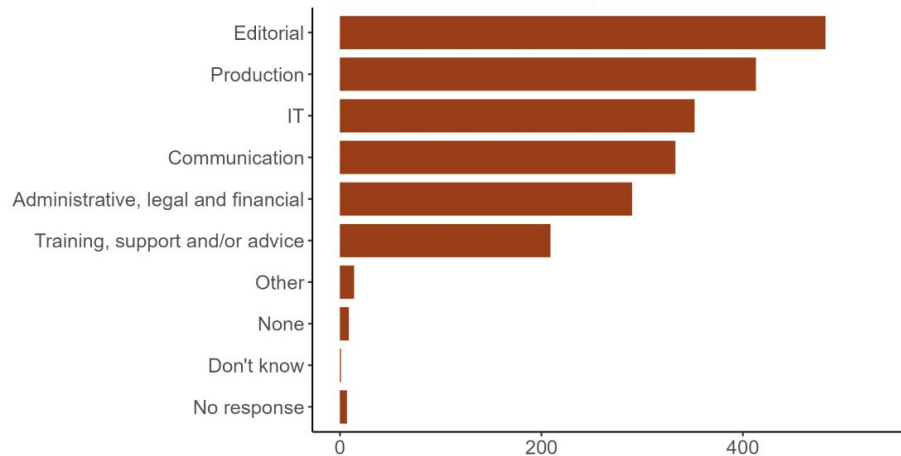




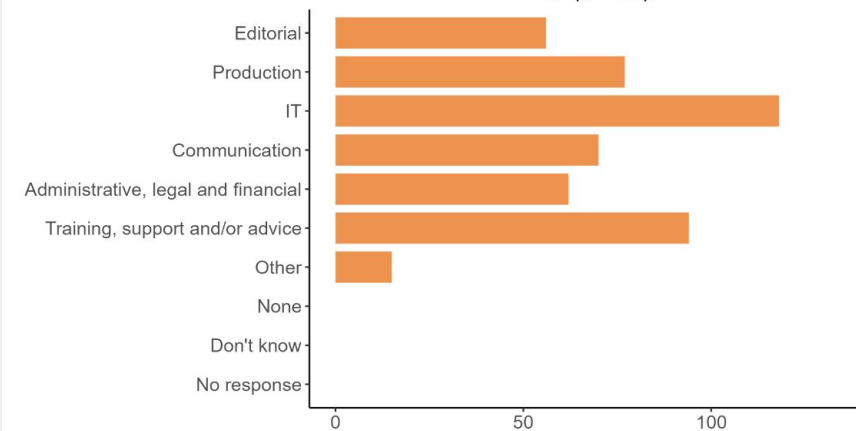

We don't have **the** needed **infrastructure** yet

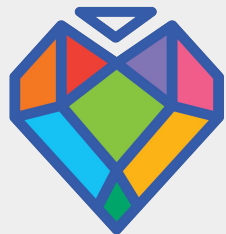

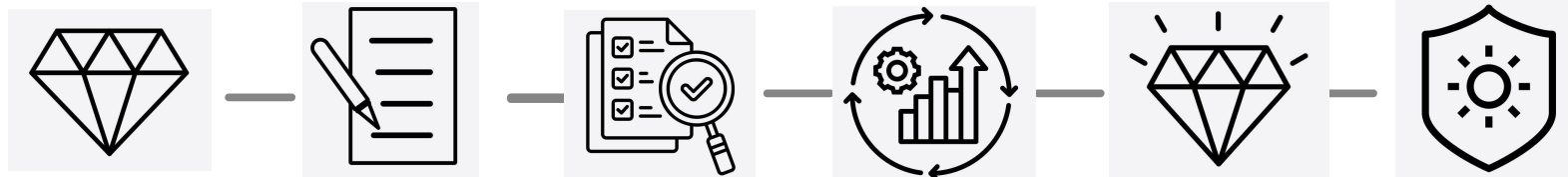

- First list from the DIAMAS survey: over 500 organisations listed who have agreed to share their information.
- Listed organisations will be able to update their description.
