



GraspOS & Barcelona DORI: mutual benefits

GraspOS: building a federated infrastructure of open resources

- \rightarrow (meta)data, tools, services, guidance material, etc.
- → Well-aligned with DORI's vision for a transition from closed to Open Research Information (ORI).

GraspOS contributes to DORI's vision in multiple ways:

- → Delivers new & improved data, tools, and services that enrich the ORI ecosystem
- → Aims to make those resources easier to discover for research assessment use cases
- → It's **pilots offer concrete examples** of research organisations trying to reform their research assessment practices through the use of ORI.
- → Investigates the effect of interventions in research assessment that can incentivise researchers to create & share ORI helping to further enrich the ecosystem.
- → By contributing to EOSC's development towards the support of research assessment reform, it can bridge DORI (and CoARA) to EOSC and enrich the EOSC ecosystem accordingly.

DORI, as an initiative, **raises awareness & visibility on the need for the transition to ORI** and applies pressure for the required reform.

- \rightarrow Helps to streamline GraspOS project activities & increase the impact of its results.
- → Its working groups may offer valuable feedback to GraspOS consortium from a wider pool of experts
